# Past Simple

1 <sup>st</sup> form of verb	2 <sup>nd</sup> form of verb
<b>V1</b>	<b>V1 + ed</b>
help	helped

We walk in the park.

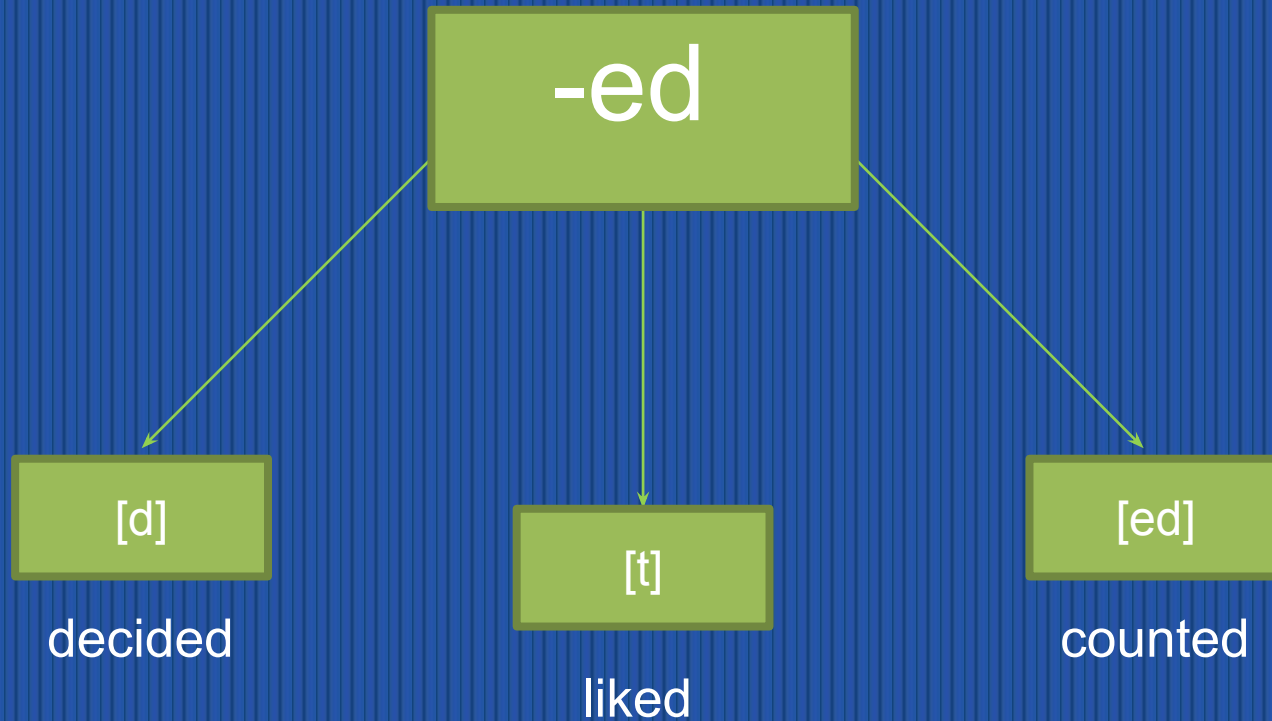
We walked in the park.

How to build an **affirmative sentence**  
in Past Simple (with regular verbs) :

<b>Noun</b> <b>(Subject)</b>	<b>Verb 2<sup>nd</sup></b> <b>form</b> <b>(Predicate)</b>	<b>Other parts</b> <b>of the</b> <b>sentence</b>
---------------------------------	---	--

Ex. **Mary** **walked** in the park yesterday.

# 3 variants of –ed pronunciation

# How to build an **negative sentence** in Past Simple :

<b>Noun</b> <b>(Subject)</b>	<b>Negation</b>	<b>Verb 1<sup>rd</sup></b> <b>form</b> <b>(Predicate)</b>	<b>Other</b> <b>parts of</b> <b>the</b> <b>sentence</b>
---------------------------------	-----------------	---	--

Ex. **Mary** **didn't** walk in the park yesterday.
