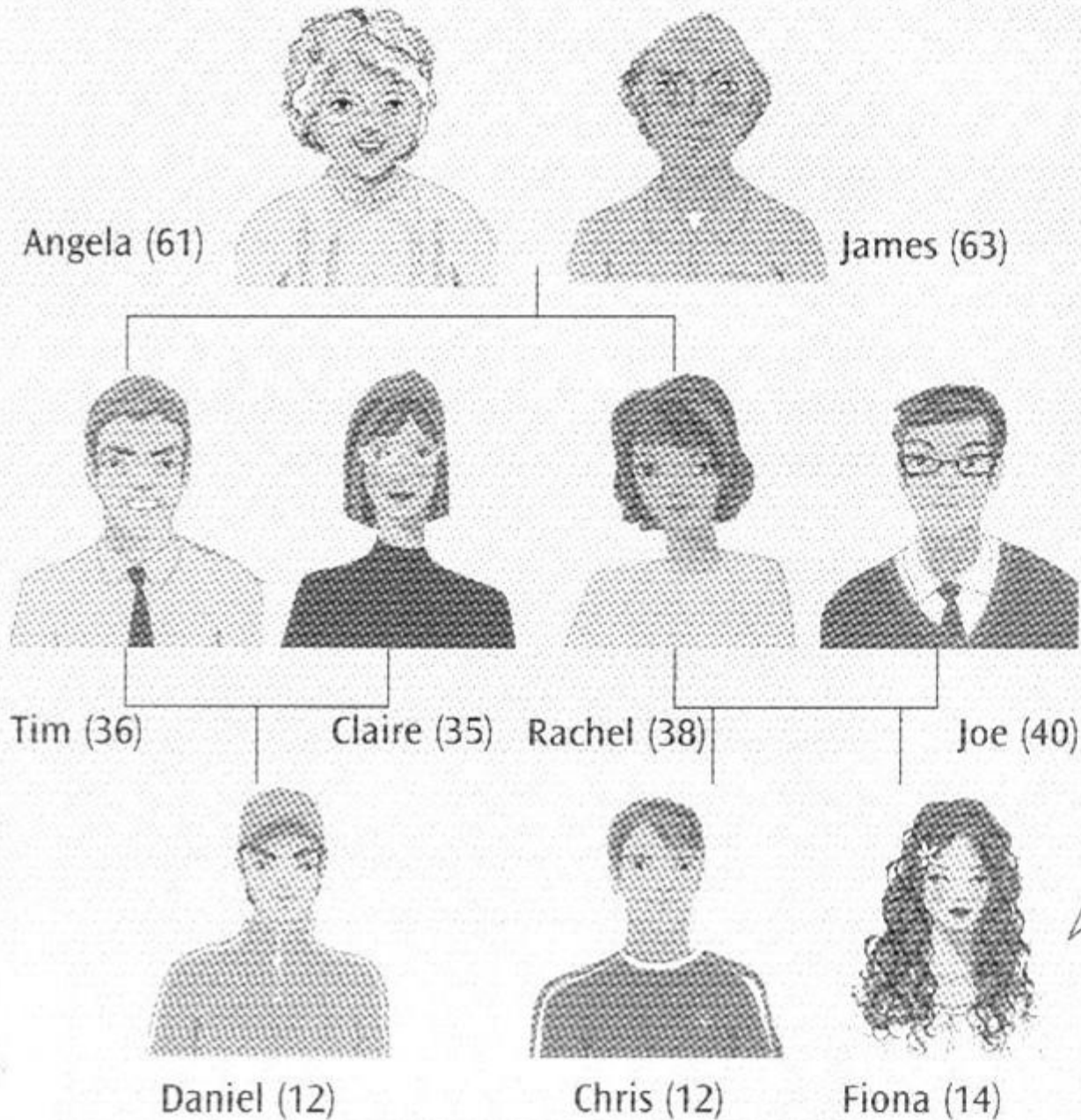

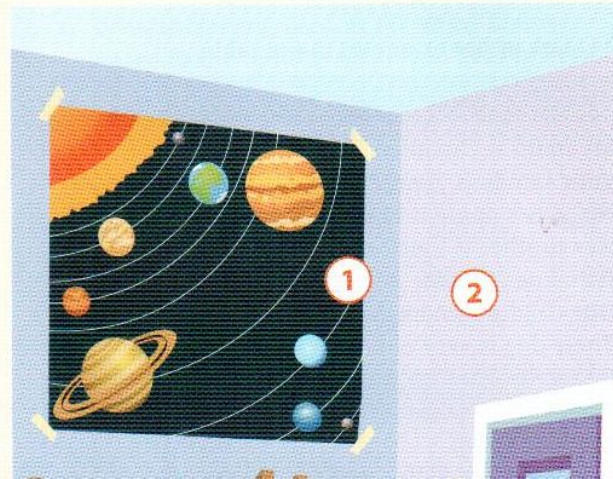

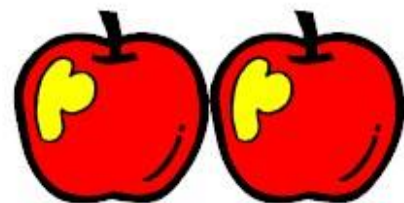


# PLURAL RULE ONE

Most words add 's' to make the plural



one apple



two apples

desk → desks

name → names

town → towns

card → cards

teacher → teachers

park → parks

month → months

truck → trucks

# Rules

To make the **plural** we usually add **-s** to the noun.

book → books

pen → pens

Nouns ending in **-s**, **-sh**, **-ch**, **-x** and some nouns ending in **-o** → **es**.

class → classes

box → boxes

watch → watches

tomato → tomatoes

Nouns ending in consonant + **y** → **ies**.

country → countries

baby → babies

But

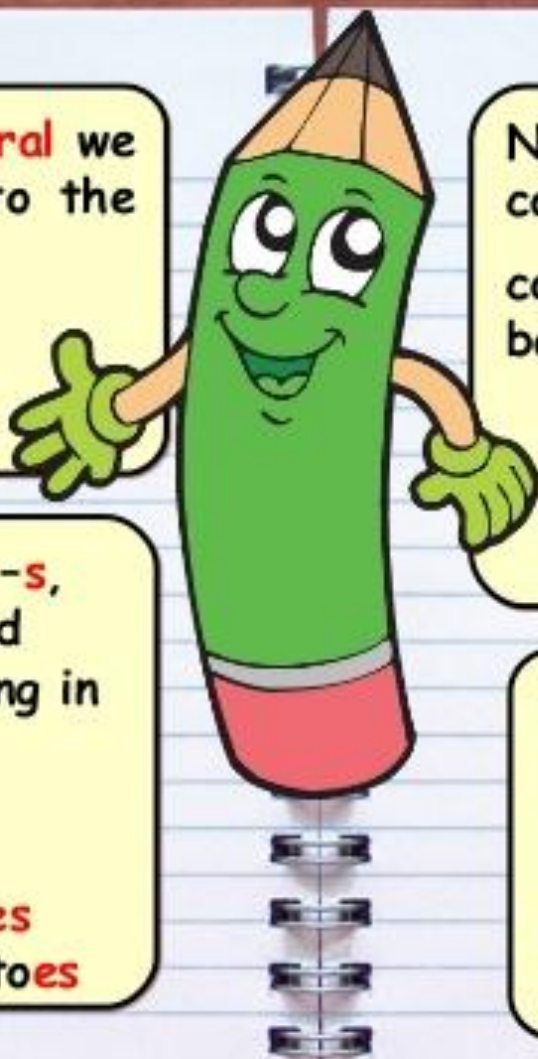
vowel + **y** → **s**

boy → boys

Most nouns ending in **-f** or **-fe** → **ves**.

knife → knives

leaf → leaves
