

D	IRECT QUESTION	ask (sb) — спрашивать want to know — хотеть знать inquire — спрашивать, справляться wonder — хотелось бы знать, интересоваться, (ему, ей) интересно	Could / Can / Would you tell me? Do you (happen) know? Do you remember? etc. (see 29) I doubt I don't know / remember I don't have any idea
