Roy Lichtenstein was born in 1923 in New York. He studied at:

- Ohio State University, State University of New York at Oswego;
- Rutgers University.

- In 1961 Lichtenstein created his first Pop Art painting.
- These included advertisement illustrations;
- Roy Lochtenstain also used other artists' works to create new pieces.
