But if they are afraid to ask for help because their classmates are watching, their studies will suffer.





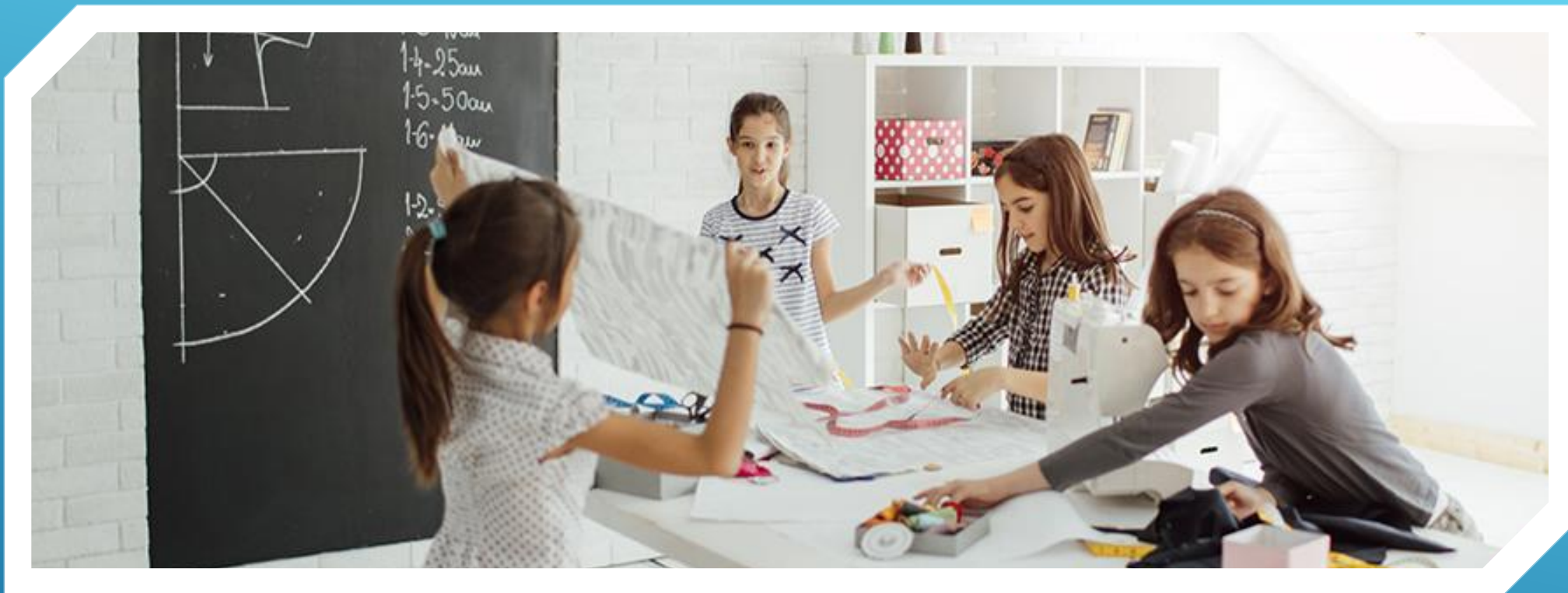
