- reformed Esperanto, was developed in 1907 in France by a group of supporters of Esperanto, which included the outstanding Danish linguist Otto Jespersen.



Ido uses the same 26 letters of the Latin alphabet as English, although the meanings of some letters differ. Ido does not use diacritics.
