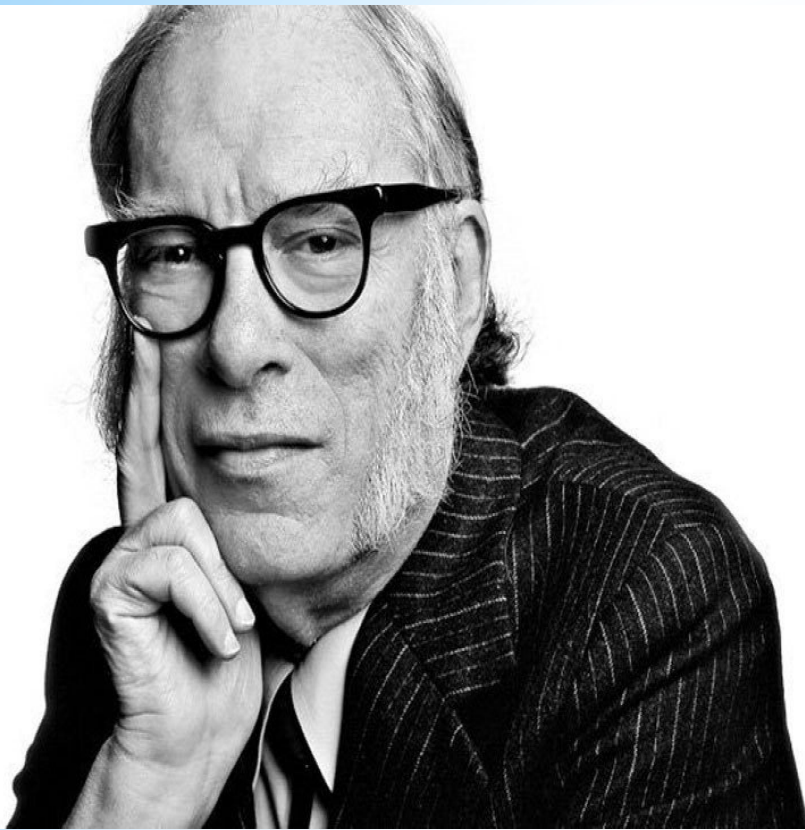


*** Famous people of

Evfrasiya Polotskaya

She was one of the first women enlighteners of the 12th century. She first translated spiritual and religious books from Greek and Latin into Belarusian language and copied them by hand.





Isaak Asimov

Science-fiction king was born in the village of Petrovichi in Mogilev Region of Belarus but lived and worked in America. A writer and professor of biochemistry at Boston University.



Alexander Chizhevsky

Was born in the Grodno region in 1897, was a famous scientist who studied the biological effects of the sun and universe.



Yanka Kupala

He is considered one of the greatest Belarusian-language writers of the 20th century



Max Mirnyi

Is a Belarusian former tennis player. He presented Belarus in Davis Cup competition in 1994 where he holds a record of 47 winning.

Zhores Alferov

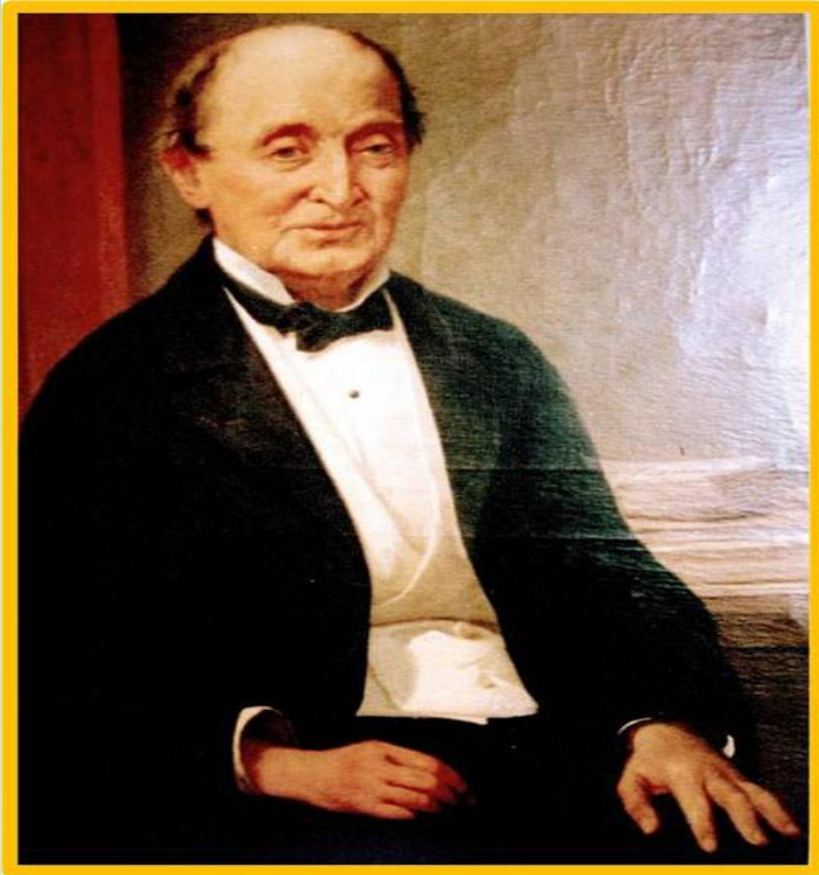
Was born in Vitebsk,

Olga Korbut

A famous former gymnast. She won 4 gold medals and 2 silver medals at the Summer Olympic Games in which she competed in 1972 and 1976

Petr Klimuk

Was the first Belarusian cosmonaut and a researcher in technical science was born in Komarovka village, Brest region, in 1942. He made three space flights as a member of spaceship and orbital space station missions.



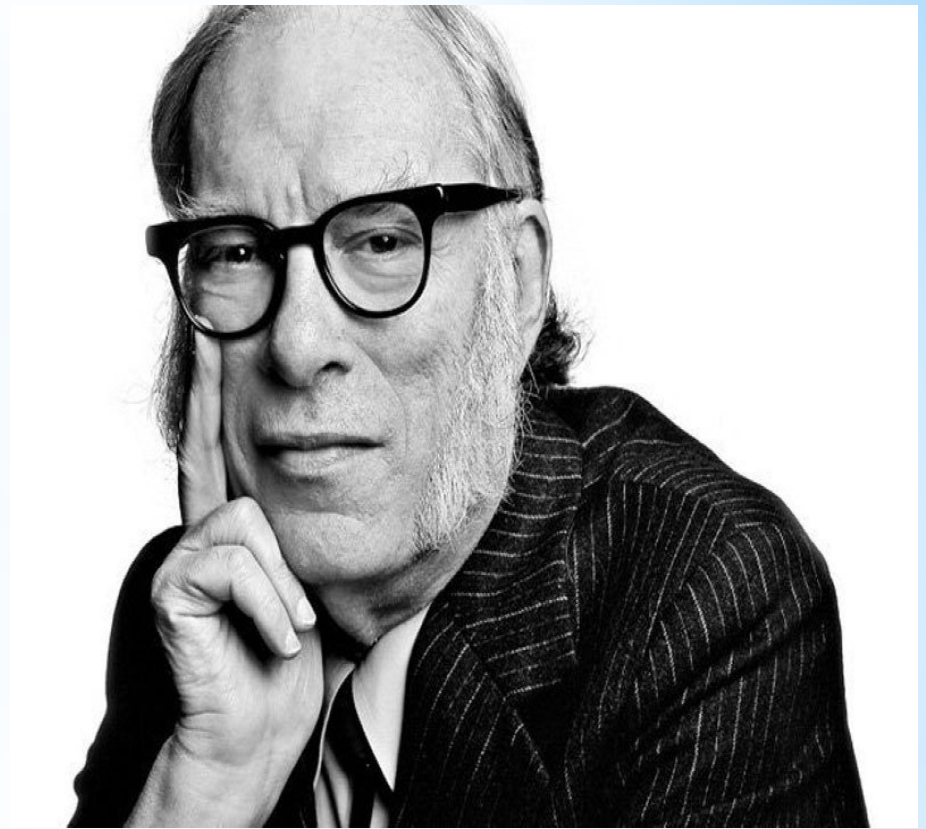
Boris Kit

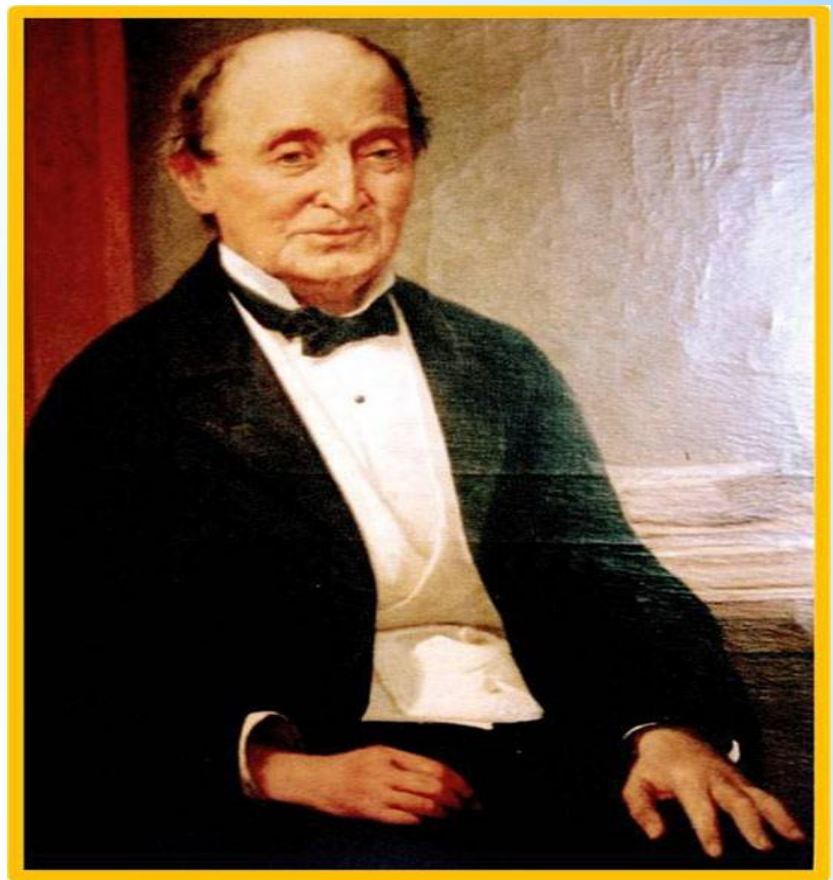


Vladimir Kovalenok
