THEATER SQUARE

Theater Square - the main square of our city is preparing surprises for you, including unique examples of the cultural and architectural heritage of the region: the memorial complex "Stella", the academic drama theater named after M. Gorky, the fountain.





Zoo

Rostov Zoo is one of the largest zoos in Russia. He is a participant in 37 programs for the conservation of rare and endangered species of animals. The zoo contains over 5,000 animals belonging to more than 400 species, of which 105 species are included in the IUCN Red List, 33 species - The Red Book of Russia, 28 species - in the Red Book Of the Rostov region, and 132 species are included in the lists of annexes of the CITES Convention.

BOLSHAYA SADOVAYA STREET

Bolshaya Sadovaya is the main street of the city. It's hard to believe that the smart girl of universities, administrations, banks, hotels and restaurants is up to the middle. The XIX century was suburban, with small wooden and rare stone houses huddled on its sides. Everything changed when

A. M. Baykov, who took over the management of the city in 1862, became the mayor.

At first, Bolshaya Sadovaya was built up slowly, but then a real construction "boom" took place, and the most extraordinary architectural structures were decorated, which became known by the surnames of the owners.





MUSICAL THEATER

The Musical Theater is a unique building in the form of an open grand piano, which has become a symbol of the city, located on Bolshaya Sadovaya.

The stage, mechanized with the latest technology, and one of the best lighting equipment in Europe allow you to create masterpieces of opera and ballet art.

PUSHKINSKAYA STREET

Pushkinskaya Street is a genuine decoration of Rostov-on-Don. By the beginning of the twentieth century, it was the second most important after Bolshaya Sadovaya.

The monument to the poet, after whom the street was named, was

erected in 1959. A special

FOUNTAIN ON THEATER SQUARE



The well-known "Stella" is a memorial To the soldiers for the liberation of the city from the Nazi invaders."

The height of the "Stella" is 72 meters and was installed on Theater Square for the 40th anniversary of Victory in the Great The Patriotic War.
