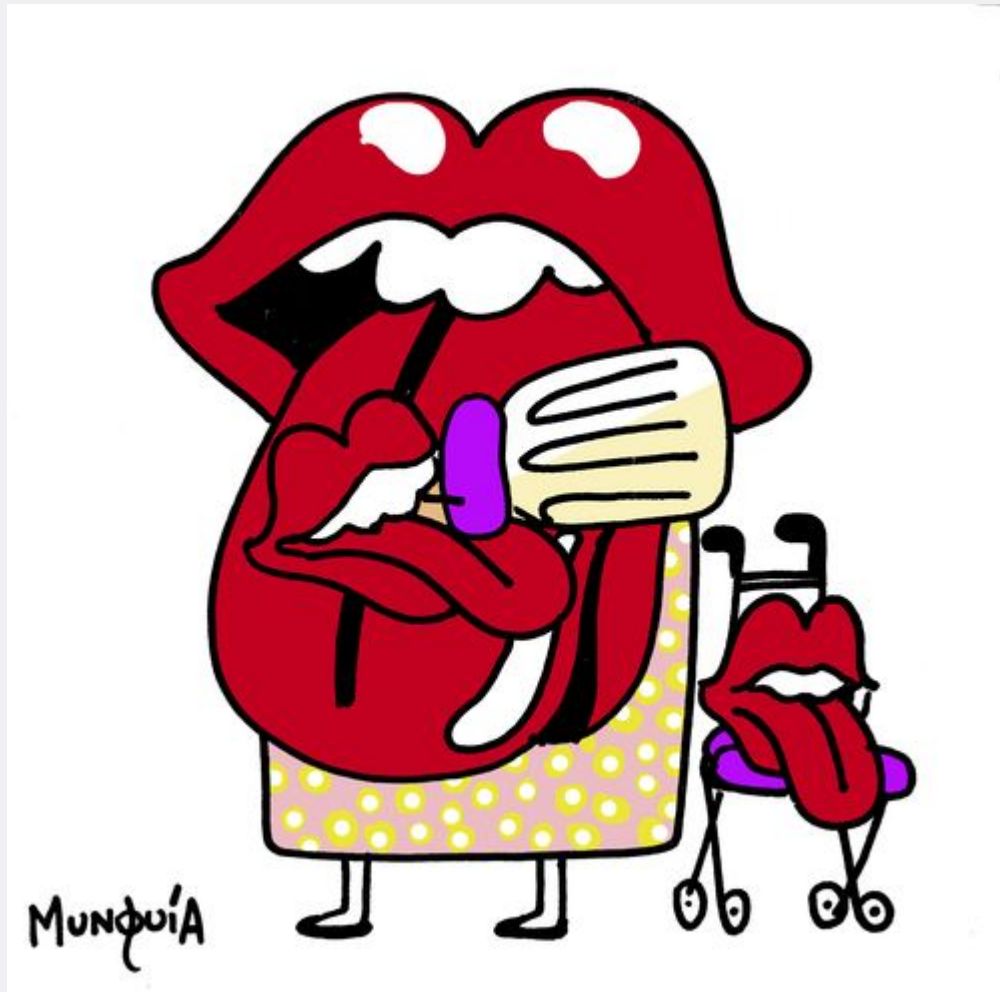


# MOTHER TONGUE

# MOTHER TONGUE /'mʌðə tʌŋ/



= the  
first language that  
you learn when you  
are a child

*Syn.* native language

# LEARNING STRATEGIES

# LEARNING STRATEGIES [ 'stræ.t.ə.dʒiːz ]



= plans, activities, techniques that people use to help them learn

- To develop / plan a strategy
- Good / effective strategy

# FOREIGN



Can you speak any FOREIGN languages?

- Yes, I can. I speak German and Chinese.



# FOREIGN /'fɒrɪn/

= belonging to or coming from another country, not your own (adj.)

- **Foreign** language / student / country
- **A foreigner** /'fɒrənə/ - noun

# NATIVE SPEAKERS /'neɪtɪv 'spi:kəz/



= someone who speaks a language as their first language

- a native speaker of English

# SLANG



‘Skint’ is SLANG for "having no money"





# SLANG /slæŋ/



= informal language,  
often language that is only  
used  
by people who belong to  
a particular group

- Slang word/expression/  
term
- To use slang

# JARGON



When you first learn about computers, there is a whole lot of JARGON to understand.



# JARGON /'dʒɑ:gən/



= words and expressions used in a particular profession or by a particular group of people, which are difficult for other people to understand

- To use jargon
- Technical / computer / business jargon

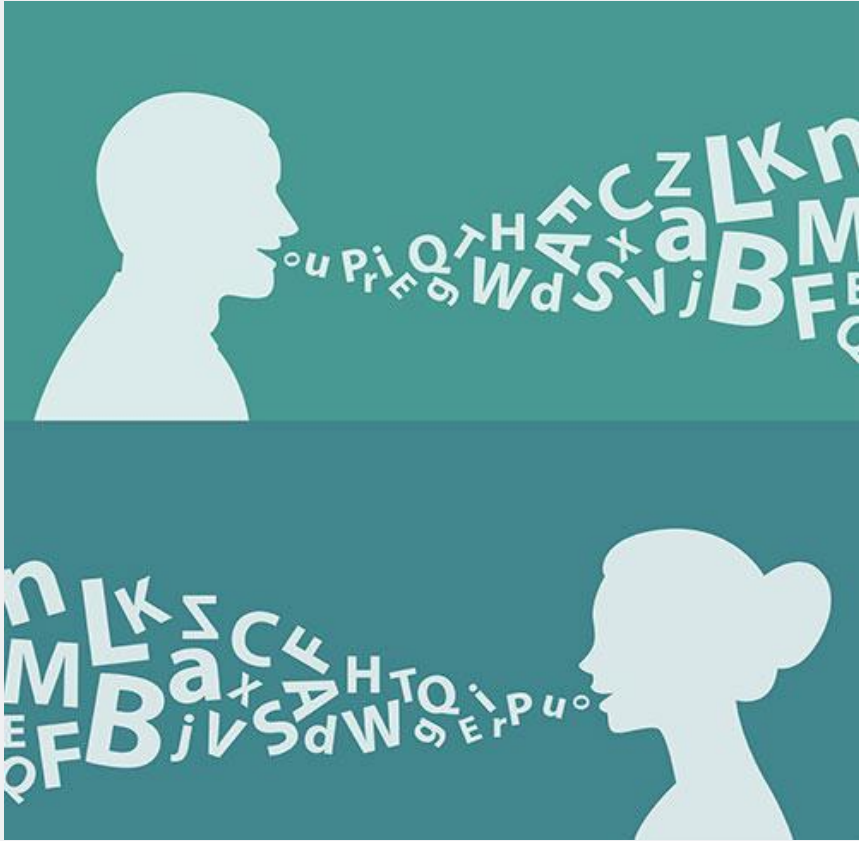
# FLUENCY



One of the requirements of the job is **FLUENCY in English and German.**



# FLUENCY /'flu:.ən.si/



= the ability to speak or write a language easily, well, and quickly, (noun)

- Speak English fluently (adv.)
- To be fluent in English
- To achieve fluency in English

# ACCURACY



One very easy way to improve your ACCURACY in English is to read any type of English material on a daily basis



# ACCURACY /'ækjʊrəsi/

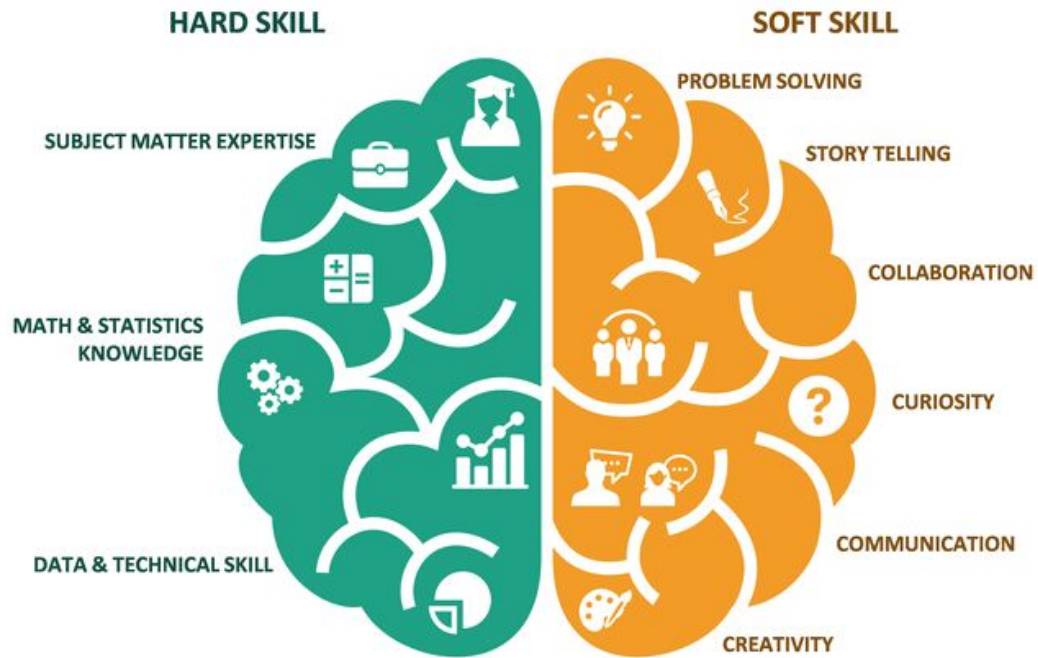


= the ability of speaking a foreign language without making mistakes

- I am accurate (adj) in English.
- I speak English accurately (adv).
- Accuracy (n) is more important than fluency for me.
- To improve accuracy in English

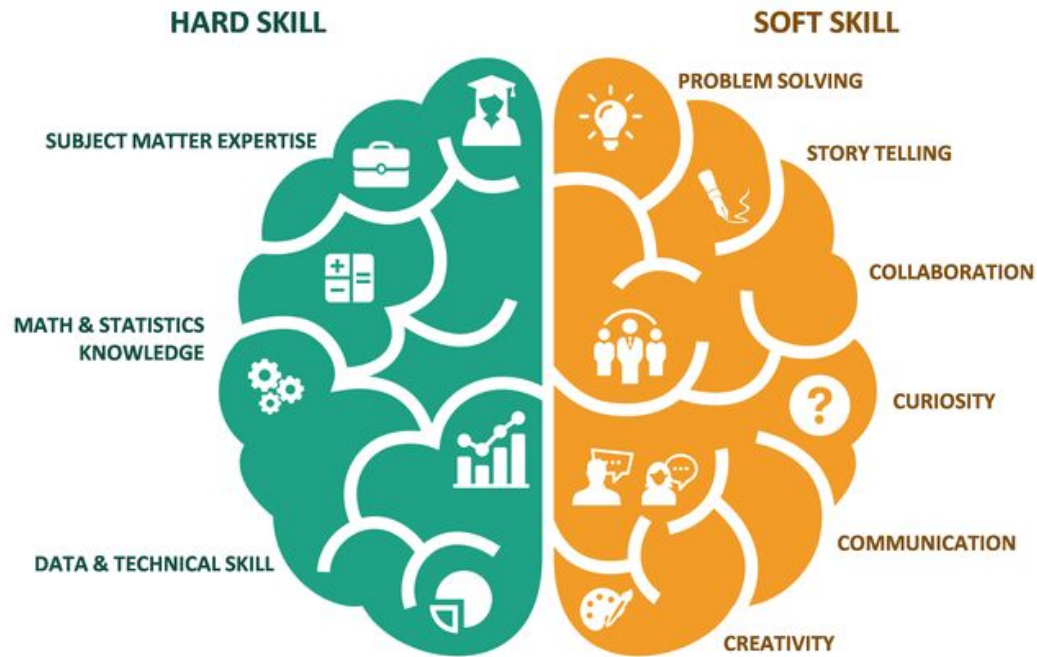

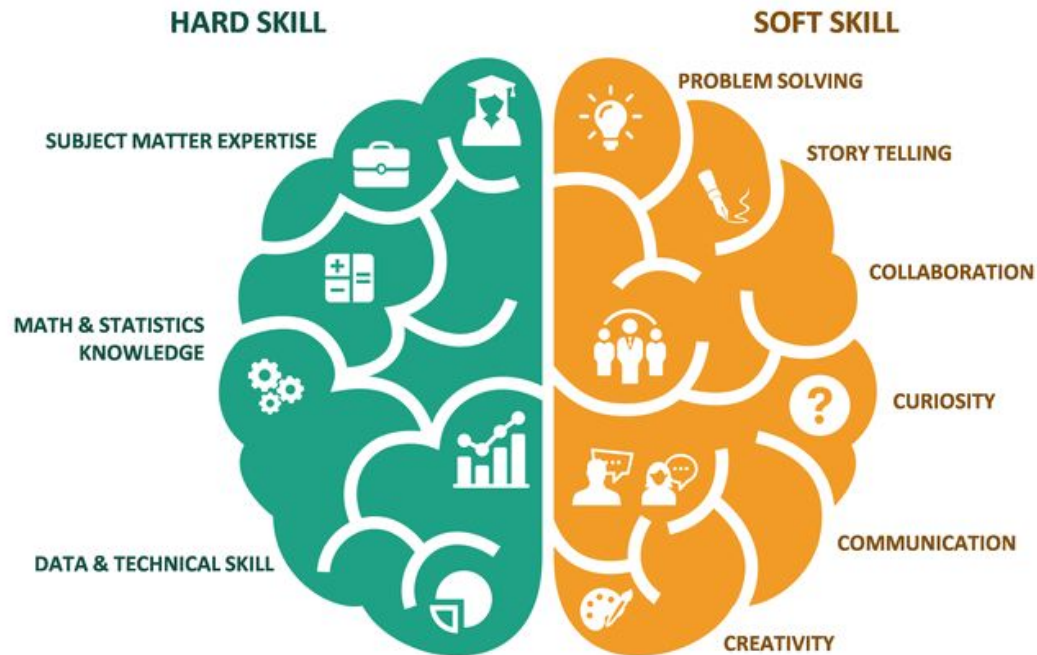

# SKILL /skil/

## HARD SKILLS & SOFT SKILLS



= an ability to do an activity or job well, especially because you have practised it

- Important / useful skills
- Language skills
- Technical / professional / computer skills
- To develop a skill

# BILINGUAL

# BILINGUAL /bɑː'lɪŋgwəl/



= speaking two languages fluently

- Be bilingual in English and Spanish
- Bilingualism
