- They are larger than daily ones and have 2 or 3 sections

Daily newspapers

- Daily newspapers are published every day except Sunday.

- Large size
- Have many detailed articles about national and international events

• Tabloids

- Smaller in size
- Have more pictures and shorter articles about less important events or about lives of well-known people

Quick! Aspin now has eight as opinion polls showed they were heading for a shake-out with Labour.

A Gallup poll for today's *Sunday Telegraph* puts the Tories on 48.5 per cent, Labour 38 and the Liberal Democrats 13.

Also had a 5.5 lead in the same survey last week.

Labour are on 38 in a *Mail* poll but *The Times* - just one point ahead of the Tories after having a seven-point lead last week.

As a 58 poll for *The Guardian* shows Labour and Tories both on 38 points, with the Libs on 10.

The same poll last week showed Labour first, Tories ahead.

The only confusion that minutes of weekly news events could be used before making up their minds. Tories had a lead last week, but now Labour were ahead.
