Halloween is celebrated on October 31.



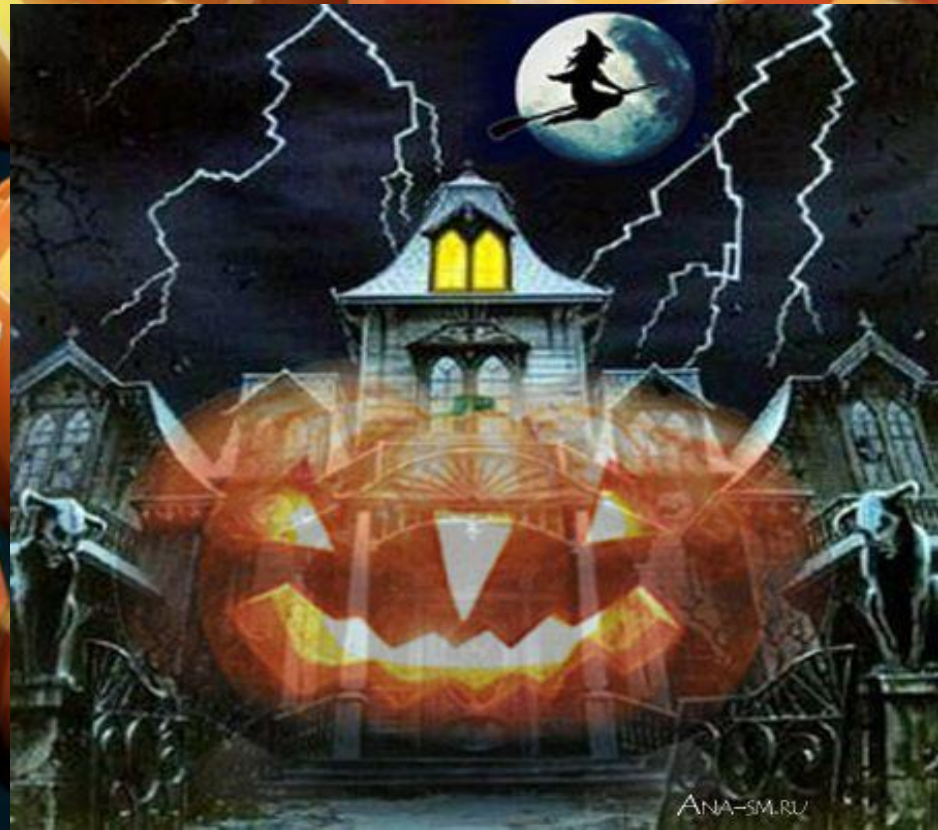
In the USA children wear costumes and masks and go trick-or-treating.

Black cat

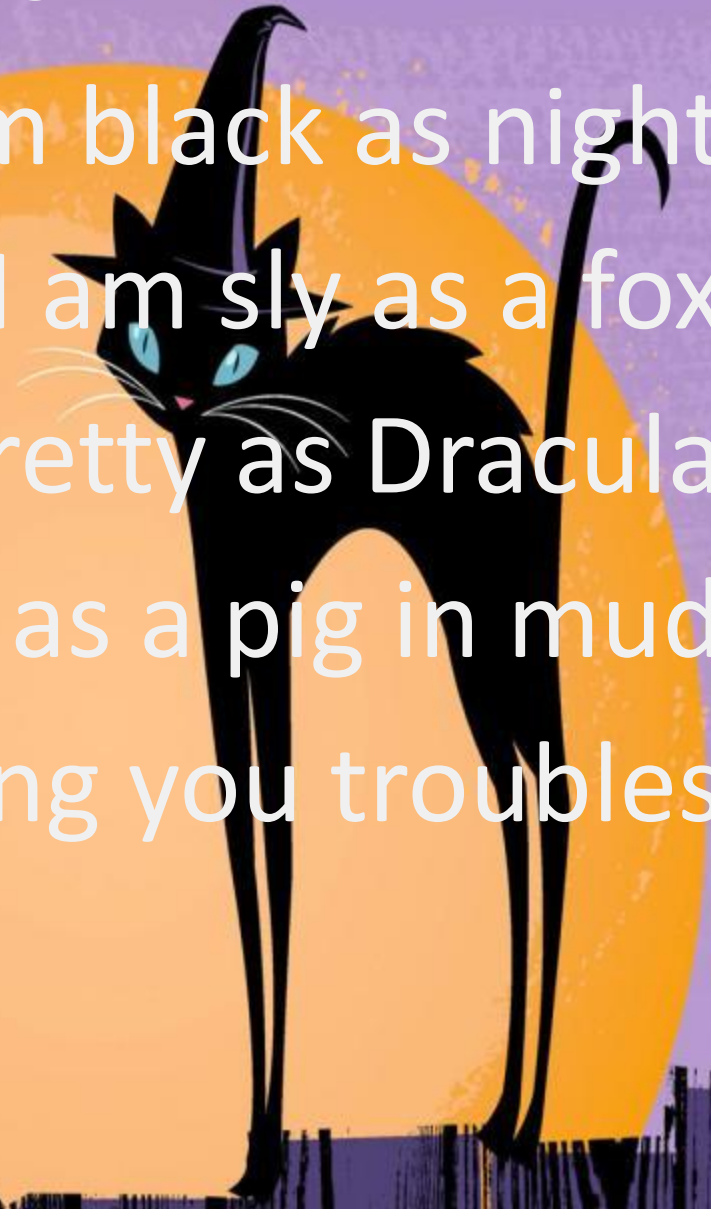
I am black as night.

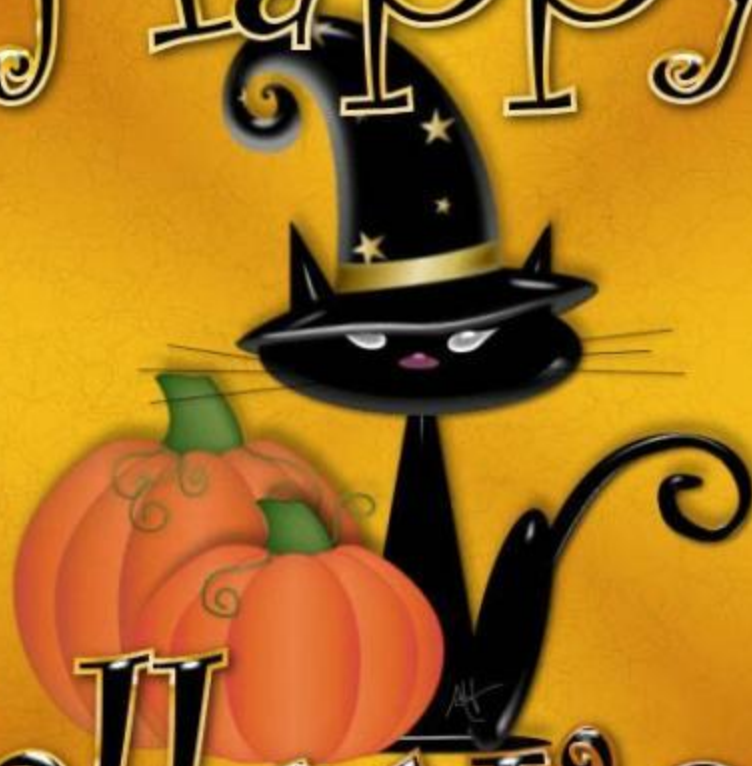
