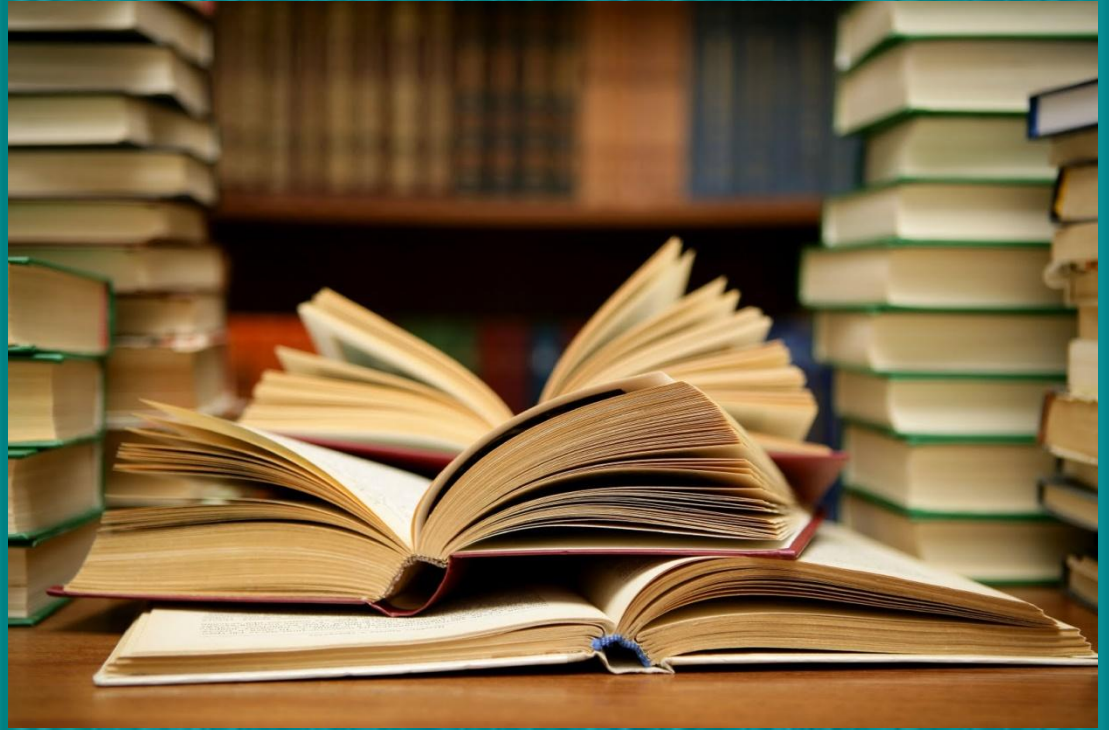
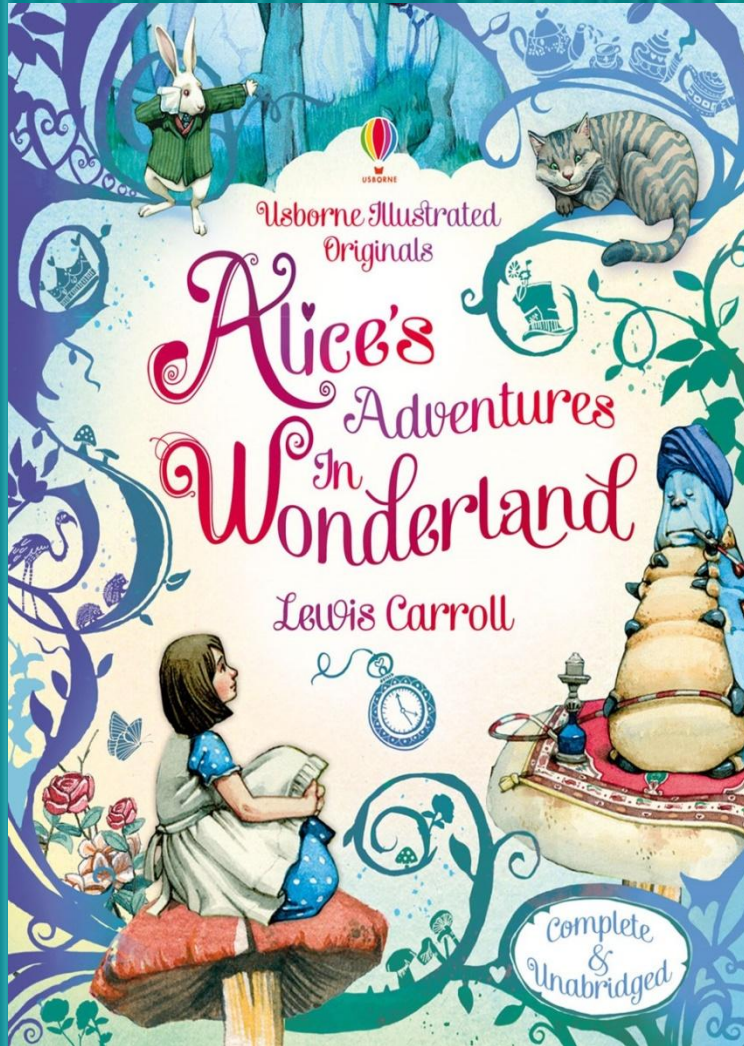

The rabbit ran fast.

- **Did not (didn't) V** Alice didn't follow the rabbit.
The rabbit didn't run fast.

? **Did ... V ...?** Did Alice follow the rabbit?
Did the rabbit run fast?
