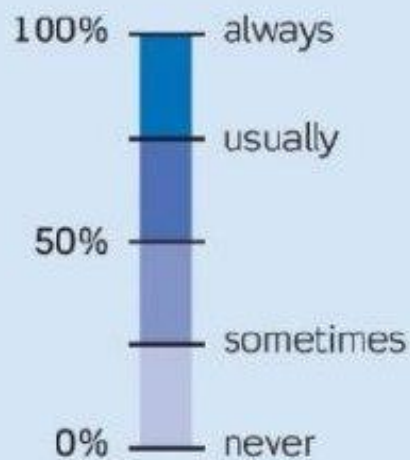

He **never** eats meat.

- Be careful with the position of adverbs of frequency:
I always have breakfast. NOT *Always I have breakfast.*
I have always breakfast.
- With *never*, use a ☐ verb: *He never eats meat.*
NOT *He doesn't never eat meat.*



- Adverbs of frequency go:
 - before the main verb;
 - between the pronoun and the verb (I *always* have coffee for lunch.);
 - between *don't/doesn't* and the main verb (I *don't* *usually* have breakfast.).
- We always use a positive verb with *never*
(He *never* eats meat.)
