









Some facts about Chris Pratt:




plenty

• You could, for instance, discuss it with John.






awesome

a disadvantage (here)

• My wife has an ability to fill in my many deficits.

make someone angry

• Tina really **annoyed** me in the meeting this morning.

UK /rɪˈfjuːz/ US /rɪˈfjuːz/


to say that you will not do or accept something:
