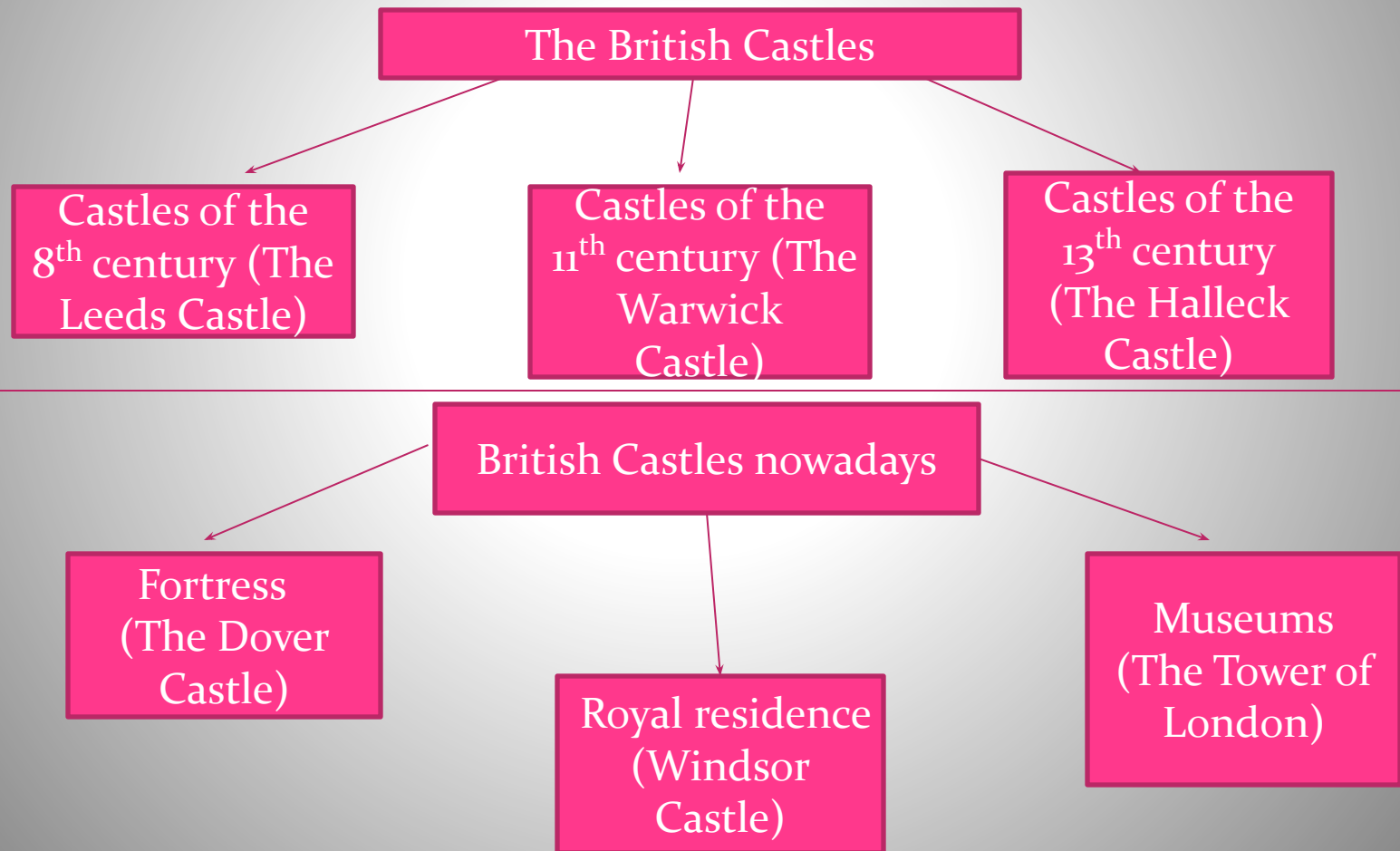

# Map of Great Britain



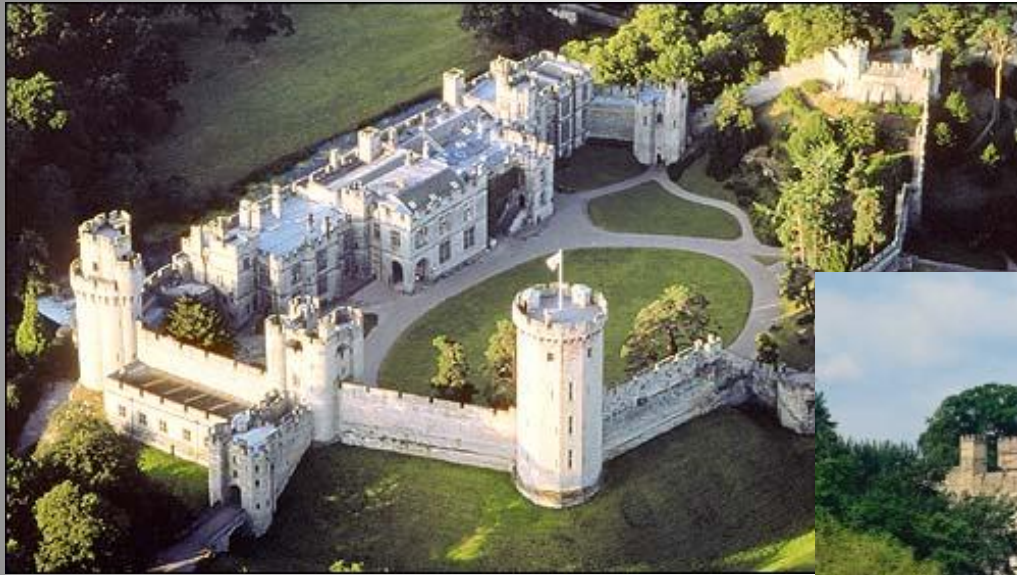
