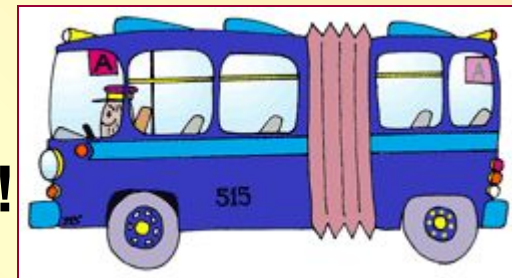
Careful! You are going to fall!

**I won`t be at school tomorrow.**

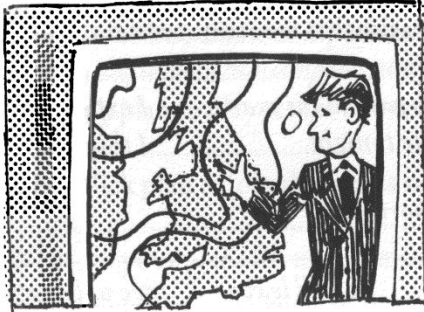
(I`m ill)

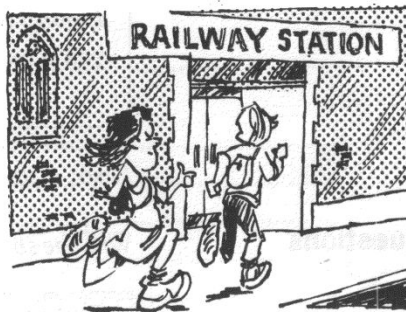

### Plan

I`m going to do lots of work this morning.

### Intention

Are you going to play basketball tonight?

### Prediction from clues

It`s going to rain this afternoon.  
(it`s cloudy)

## will / won`t

### Promise

I`ll do lots of work this evening.

### Refusing

Will you wash the floor?  
No, I won`t! You made it dirty!

### Prediction formal

Tomorrow it will probably rain in the afternoon. (forecast)

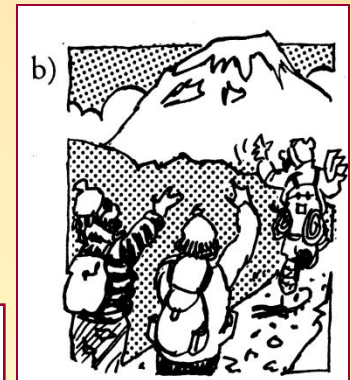
