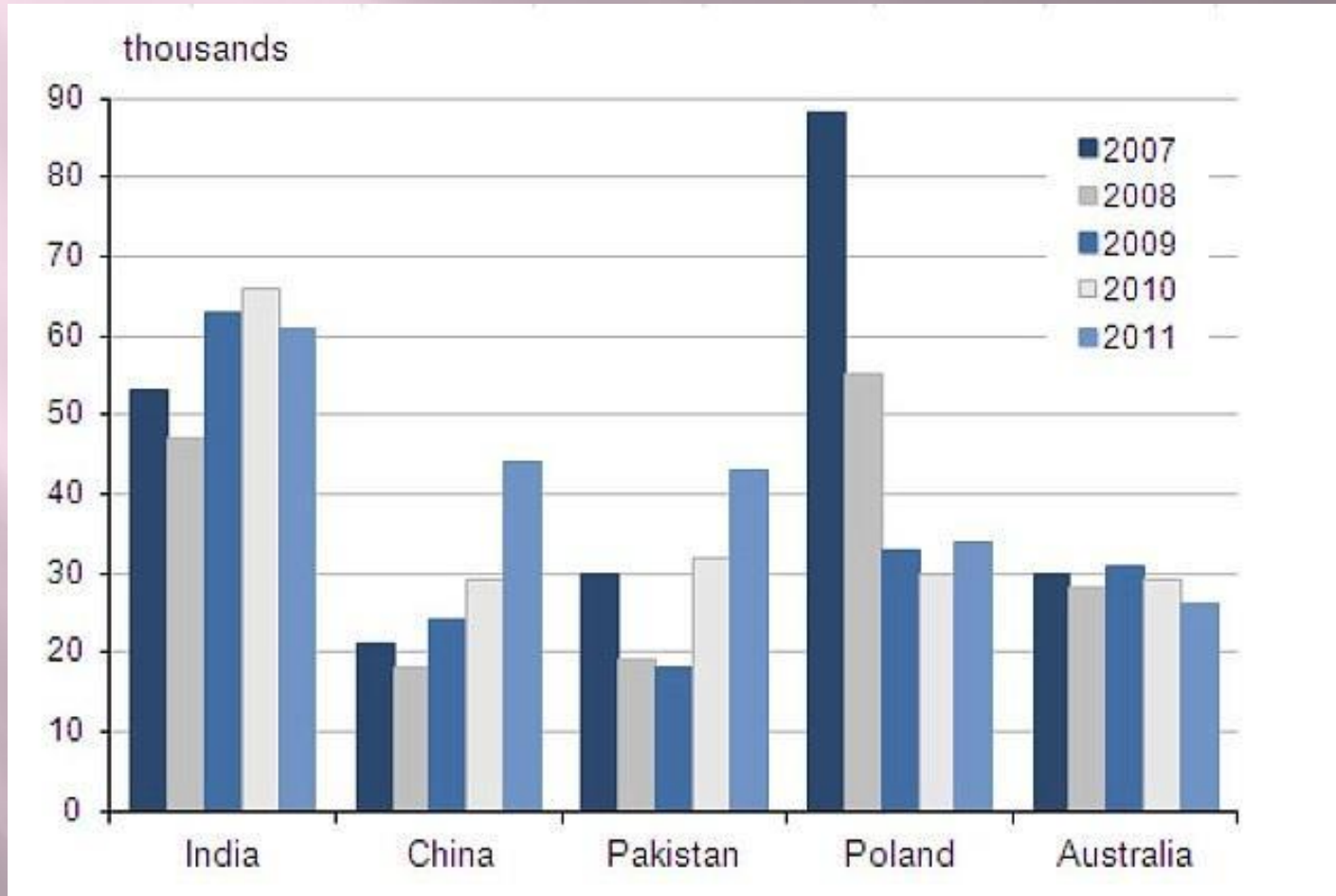




# IMMIGRATION INTO UK TODAY

- The population of Britain will be 70 million by 2028, Britain is facing an immigration crisis
- the Government has stated that around 190,000 migrants arrive in Britain every year and the Office for National Statistics (ONS) has said that Britain's population will increase
- English is not the first language of more than half a million pupils in Britain's primary schools it is a straightforward consequence of the enormous amount of migration into Britain over the past decade

# WHY IS IMMIGRATION INTO BRITAIN SO HIGH?

- ▣ The reason why people from developing countries want to live here is obvious: life is better here than in the impoverished countries from which they came
- ▣ Britain is more hospitable to immigrants than other European countries.
- ▣ One of the great virtues of the British people is their tolerance.
- ▣ It is easier for immigrants who arrive here to claim benefits, get council housing and access health and education services for themselves and their children and it becomes clear why Britain is a target for migrants.
