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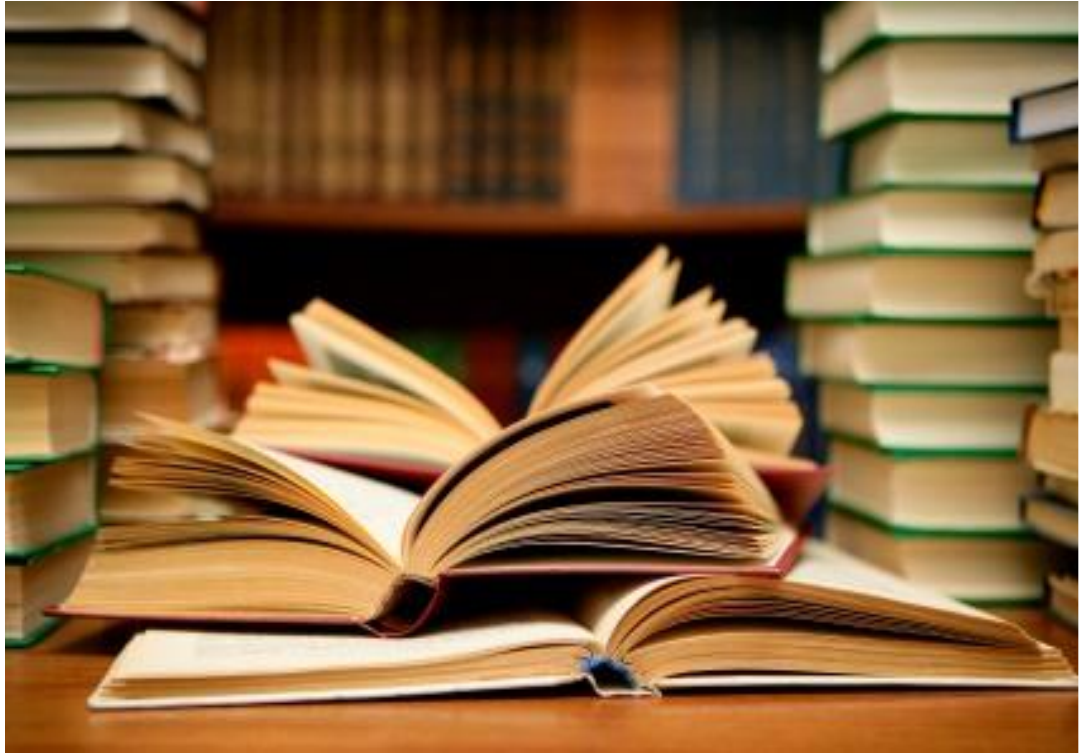

(THINGS THAT HAVE ALREADY HAPPENED!)

## REGULAR VERBS

I walk to school	→	I walk <u>ed</u> to school
I jump on my bed	→	I jump <u>ed</u> on my bed
I like <u>e</u> it	→	I like <u>d</u> it

# PAST SIMPLE

(THINGS THAT HAVE ALREADY HAPPENED!)

## IRREGULAR VERBS

- I go to school ➡ I **went** to school
- I write a letter ➡ I **wrote** a letter
- with irregular verbs: 2nd column of the table of the irregular verbs
- **yesterday, last year (week, month) a year ago (month, week, day), long ago, during the**

# **FIND IN THE TEXT:**

## **□ Irregular verbs:**
