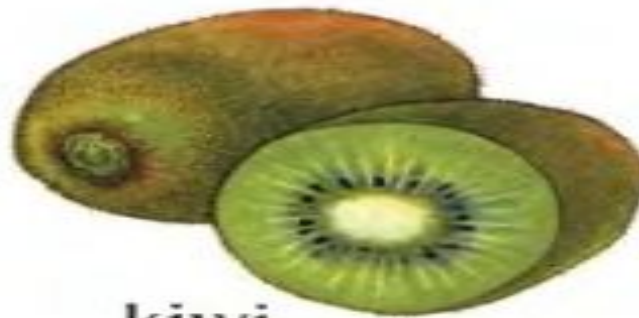

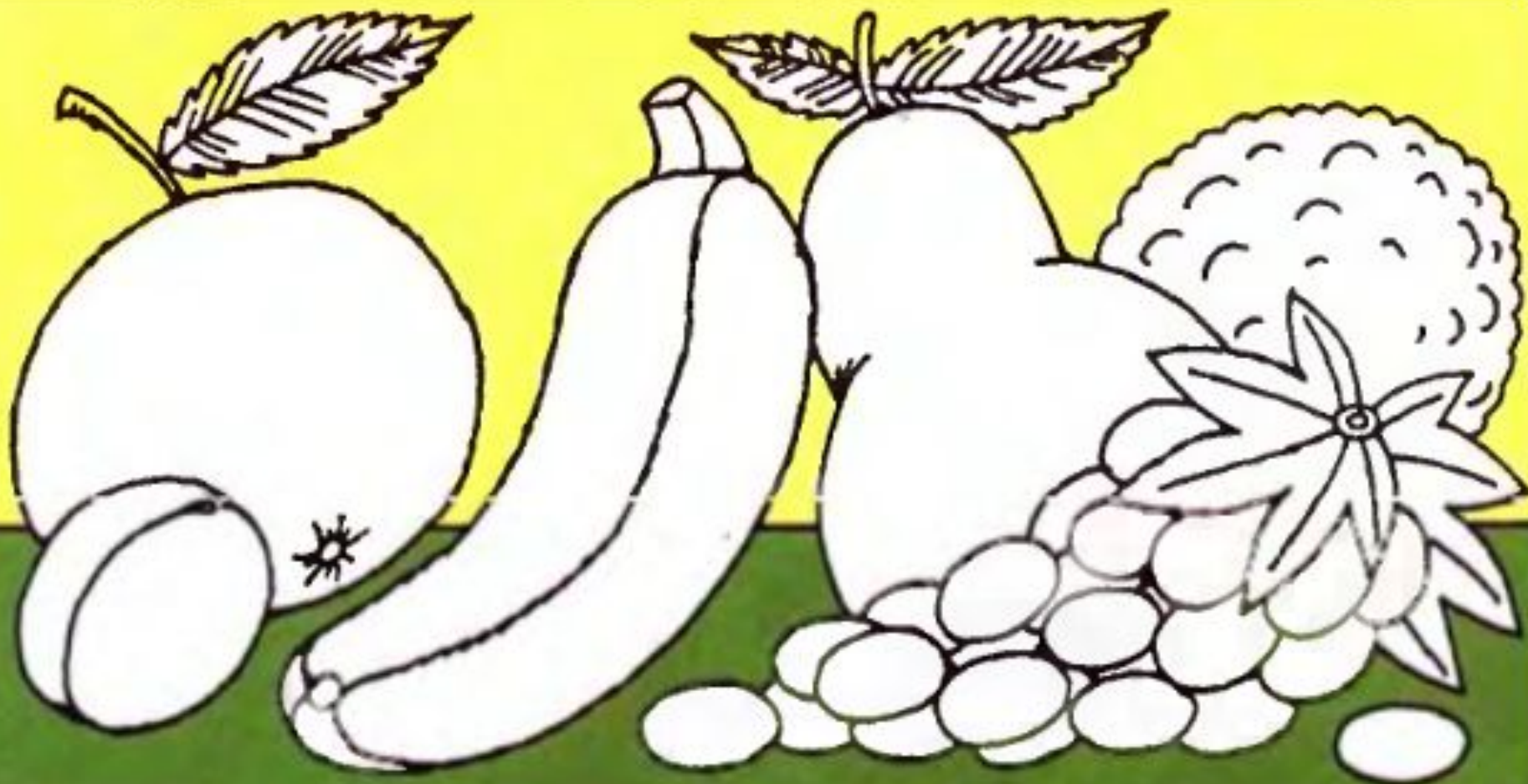

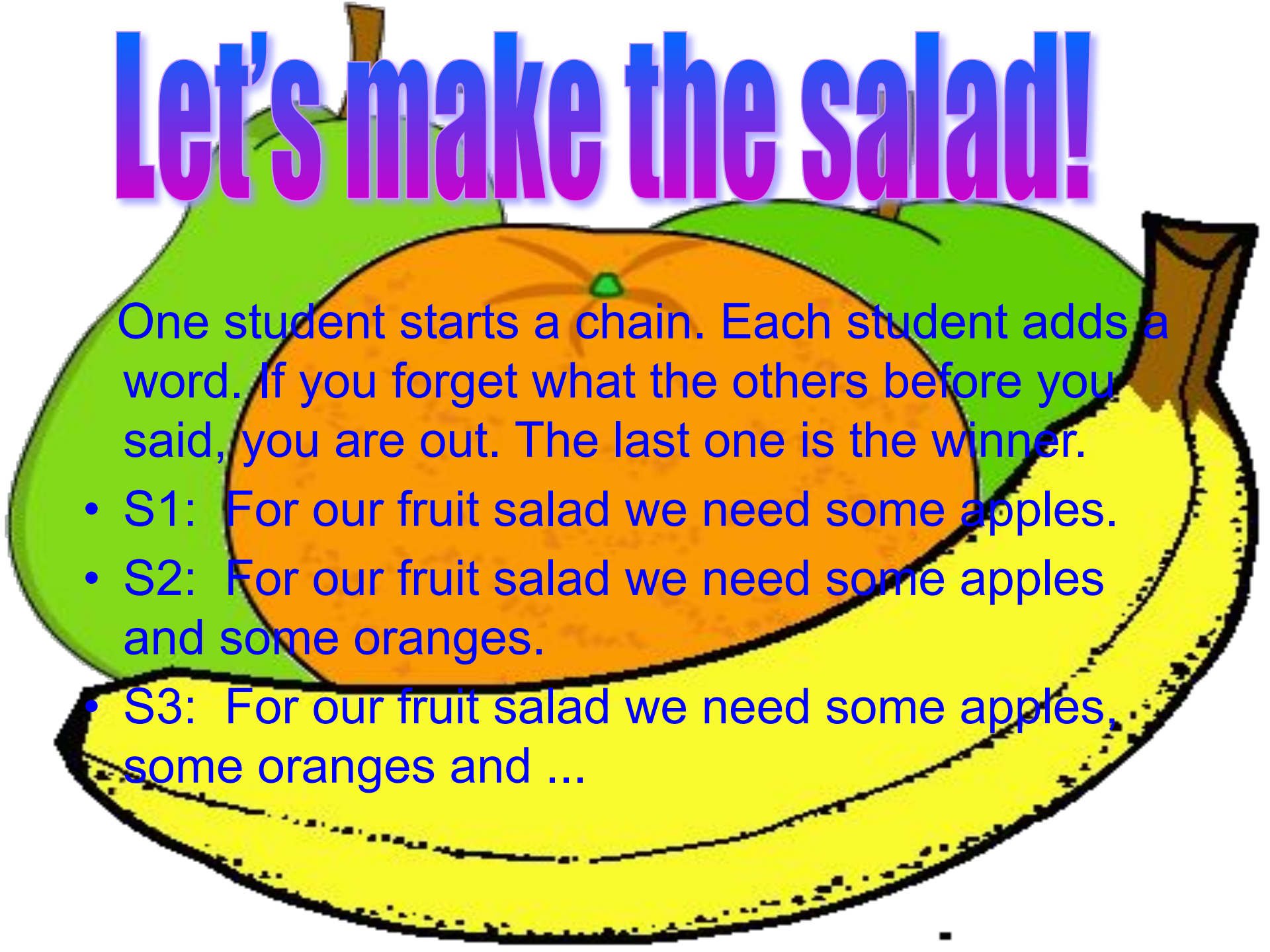

T: Good. 1 point for...

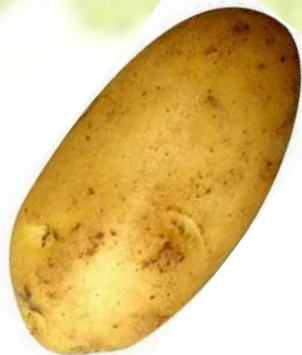
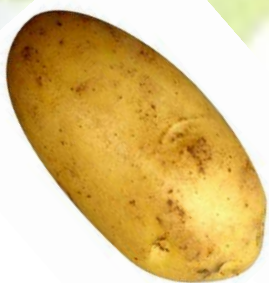
