

Относительные местоимения

В английском языке
придаточные определительные
предложения могут вводиться
относительными
местоимениями who (whom),
whose, which.

- The man who /whom I met yesterday was my uncle.
- The boy whose name is Jack Hobbs is our best student.
- The book which I'm reading now is very interesting.

Запомни, что , когда речь идёт о людях, используются местоимения who (whom), когда речь идёт о неодушевленных предметах и животных – which. При этом очень часто which и who опускаются.

This is the book (which) you wanted to read.

This is the man (who) you wanted to see.

Во многих случаях вместо who и which можно использовать that.

- This is the book that you wanted to read.
- This is the man that you wanted to see.

- I like the video that I bought yesterday.
- The boy that wrote this poem is my best friend.
- The dog that is running to the house is Rex.
- Where is the picture that Uncle Fred painted?
- Mr. Jones is my friend, that lives in Canada.

- This is the cake that I made.
