6. Church



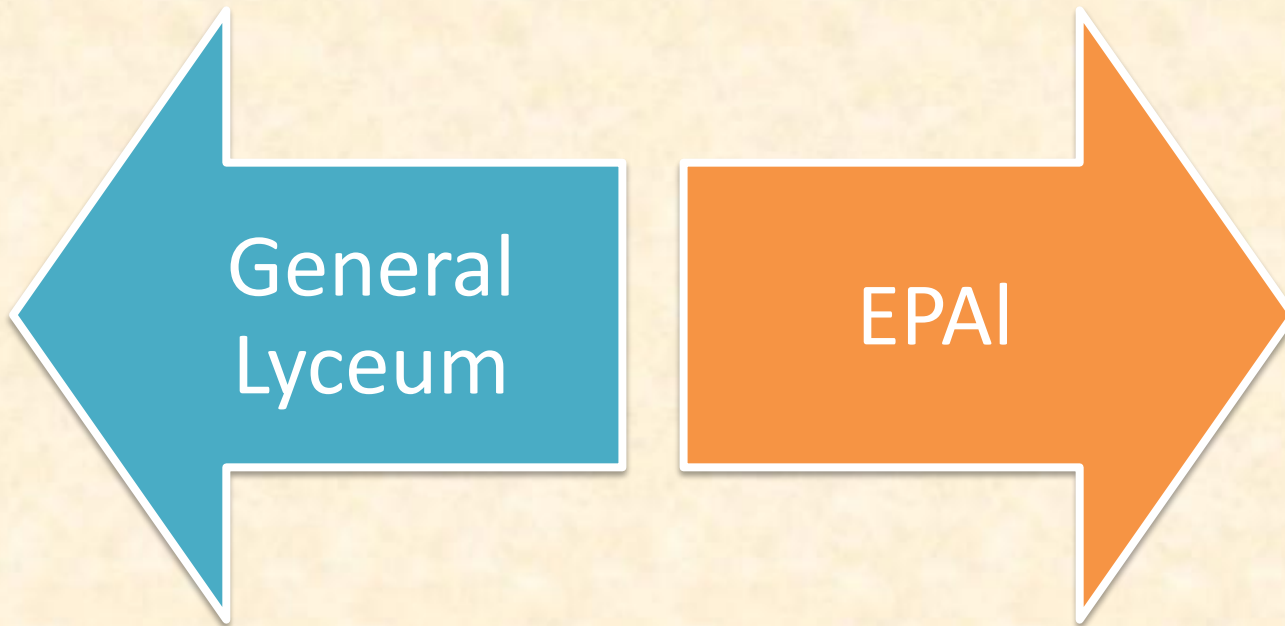


After graduate the Gymnasium , they have two option:
