Room blocks 99.99 percent of external sounds , and no one has yet been able to endure for more than 45 minutes , being in it .

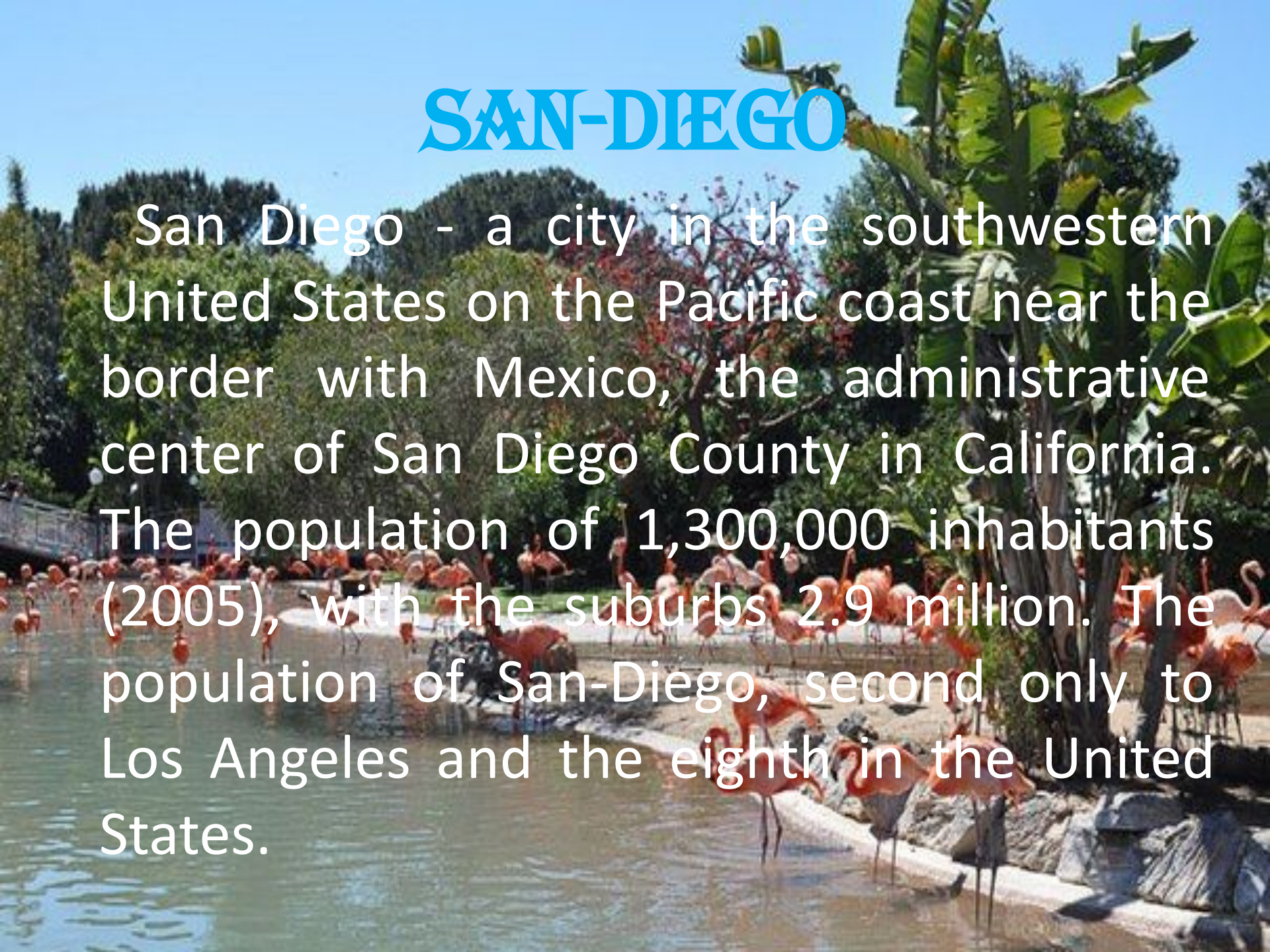
"The quieter the room, the more things you hear. You start to hear your heart beating , sometimes as moving your lungs or your stomach is rumbling like . In an anechoic chamber, you yourself become sound " - said Steven Orfield .

Orfield explained that this is very confusing and makes you sit in one place . We focus on the sounds that we hear when we walk . In the camera , you do not have any signals that allow you to balance and maneuver . If you find yourself here for half an hour , it is best to stay in the chair .

According to him, most people are not distracting noise and the silence.

SAN-DIEGO

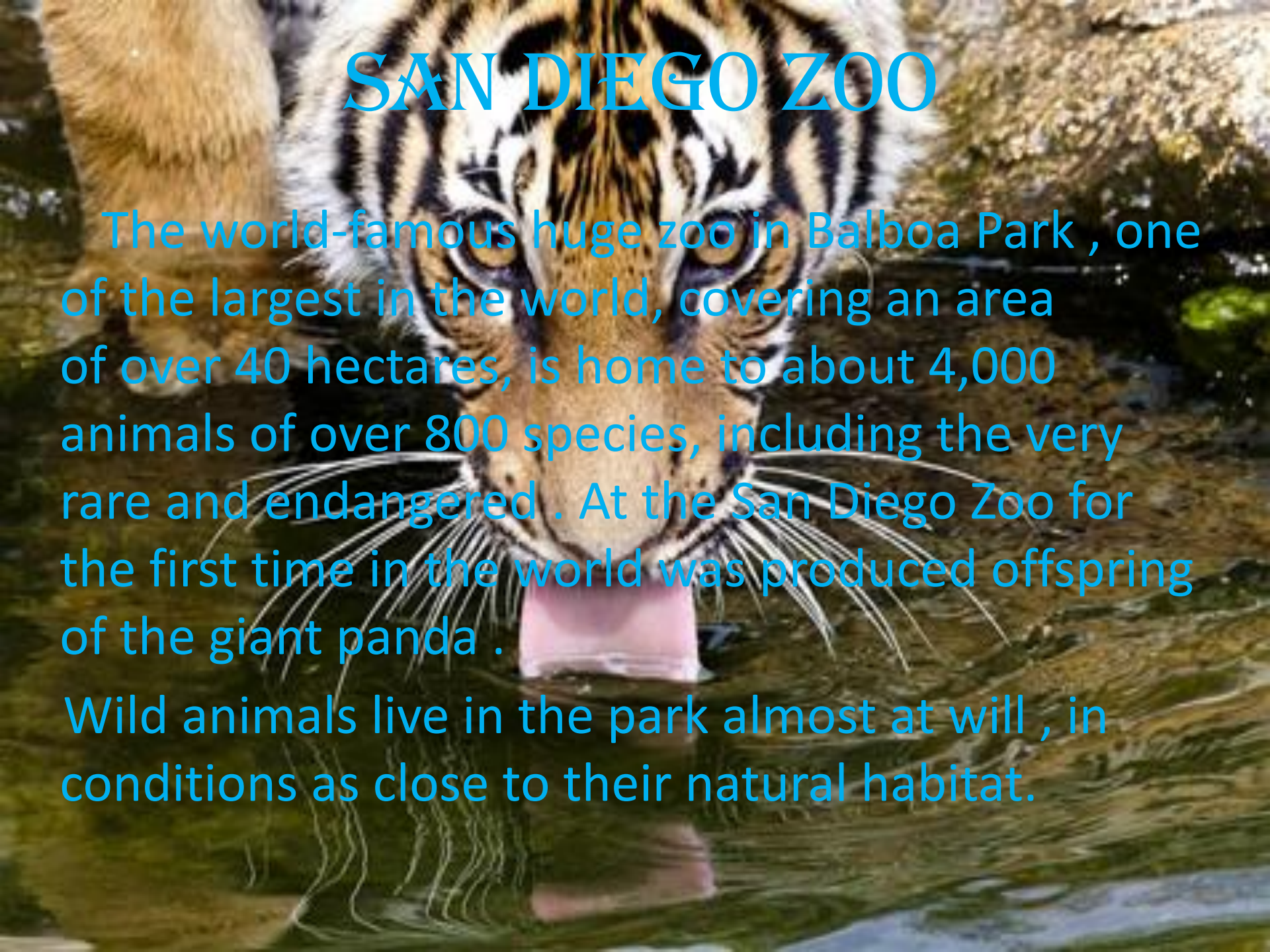
CENTRAL PARK IN SAN DIEGO BALBOA PARK

At the San Diego Zoo for the first time in the world was produced offspring of the giant panda .

Wild animals live in the park almost at will , in conditions as close to their natural habitat.

SEAWORLD SAN DIEGO

Park "Sea World" in San Diego - the world famous marine animal park , located in a beautiful bay , the first of aquariums SeaWorld, opened in 1964 and immediately became one of the main attractions of San Diego. This is a huge theme park dedicated to the world's oceans and its inhabitants , with a variety of attractions , entertainment and educational programs. On a huge water stadium Shamu are great shows with great whales . Visitors can swim with dolphins or chat with penguins . SeaWorld - it's a great opportunity to see firsthand the many inhabitants of the world's oceans .

DID YOU KNOW THAT SAN DIEGO IS VERY COMMON DOG SURFING?

Annual championship canine surfing Loews Coronado Bay Resort takes place on the beach in San Diego in the U.S. state of California. This year's collection of pets and their owners surfers took place for the seventh time . For the ultimate prize - a chance to relax in the hotel Loews Coronado and name t-shirts - they fought more than 50 athletes of different breeds and colors from all over the country.

Every dog has 10 minutes to catch a wave . The competitors evaluated on several criteria , including the duration of the performance , the size of the waves , the degree of confidence in the management board and even style . The four-legged athletes compete in three categories : small and large dogs , as well as "tandem surfing " when on one board are a few dogs or people . Every surfer is swimming goggles and an inflatable vest on a performance. Lessons and master classes for juniors are on the beach for an hour before the competition starts.

Admission is free for spectators , while the involvement of the owners in the league will cost \$ 50. All proceeds goes, usually for charity.

LEGOLAND CALIFORNIA

Children's dreams come true about the world of LEGO in this theme park in Carlsbad (Carlsbad - town 20 miles north of San Diego), built of the popular colored blocks, bricks. The park contains more than 50 different shows and attractions, including Miniland USA "America in miniature", which shows the 7 regions of the United States, collected from 20 million colored bricks LEGO.
