* Its name is derived from the nickname for New York, the Empire State. It stood as the world's tallest building for 40 years (from 1931 to 1972).



Facts about the ESB

- It is a 102-story landmark skyscraper and American cultural icon in New York City at the intersection of Fifth Avenue and West 34-th Street. It has a roof height of 1,250 feet (381 m),and with its antenna spire included, it stands a total of 1,454 ft (443,2 m) high.

Architect
