Others say he used shamrocks to teach about the Trinity



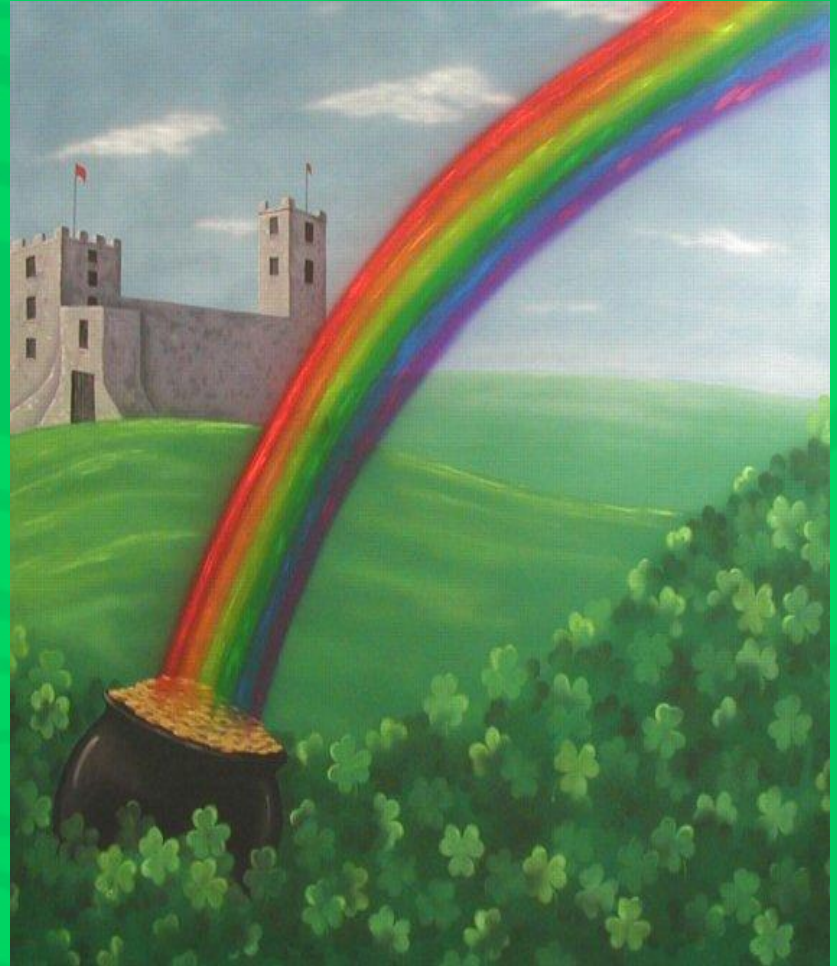
He died March 17 in 461 A.D.
