Способы выражения будущего времени

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There are several ways to express the future.

- 1. WITH THE MODAL WILL.
- 2. With BE GOING TO.
- 3. With the present simple.
- 4. With the present continuous.

WILL

We use the modal WILL + the infinitive form of the main verb for:

1. Predictions.

You will get married and have 10 children!

l'Il have a cup of coffee, please!

2. Quick decisions.



Ok! I'll call you tomorrow

3. Promises, offers, warnings.

I WILL ('II) call
You WILL ('II) call
He / She WILL ('II) call
We WILL ('II) call
You WILL ('II) call
They WILL ('II) call

BE GOING TO

We use BE GOING TO + the infinitive form of the main verb for:

1. Plans / Intentions.



2. Predictions based on clear signs.

Look at those clouds! It is going to rain







I am going to practise hard to become a rock star!

I am going to + V

You are going to + V

He / She is going to + V

We are going to + V

You are going to + V

They are going to + V

THE PRESENT SIMPLE

We use the present simple when we talk about:

- 1. <u>Timetables</u>.
- 2. Programmes.
- 3. Schedules.





My train leaves in 15 minutes!

leave

You leave

He / She / It leaves

We leave

You leave

They leave

THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS

We use the present continuous when we have:

1. Plans.

2. Arrangements.

Sorry, I'm playing tennis on Monday, but I'm not doing anything on Tuesday.



I am playing
You are playing
He / She is playing
We are playing
You are playing
They are playing

ANSWER

They ARE VISITING some of their relatives in Wales this weekend.
(PLANS)

ANSWER

I WILL ('II) have mayonnaise, please.
(QUICK DECISION)
