The History of the Development of Democracy in America

- 1607 The first successful English colony (Jamestown)
 was founded in the present state of Virginia.
- July 4, 1776, the Continental Congress adopted the Declaration of Independence.
- The Treaty of Paris was signed in 1783.
- March 1789 The American representative (indirect) democratic system in the form of a constitutional republic was established in the Constitution of the United States.
- There are 27 amendments which have been added to the Constitution. The most important are:
 - 13 outlaws slavery
 - 14 guarantees all citizens equal protection of the laws
 - 19 gives women the right to vote (Ratified in August, 1920)


