

William Shakespeare – some biographical notes






The early years

◆ Born in April 1564 in Stratford on Avon

Wife and Children

- Marriage to Anne Hathaway in 1582
- Anne was 26, he was 18
- ◆ 3 children
- The youngest, Hamnet died at the age of 11

opened in 1599

He became one of
the principal investors



Ups and downs

- Failures and successes
- The affair with the "Dark Lady"



The end of his life

- Return to Stratford in 1610
- Destruction of the Globe Theatre in 1613 (the Great Fire of London)
- In 1616 Shakespeare died on April, 23 (his birthday!)
