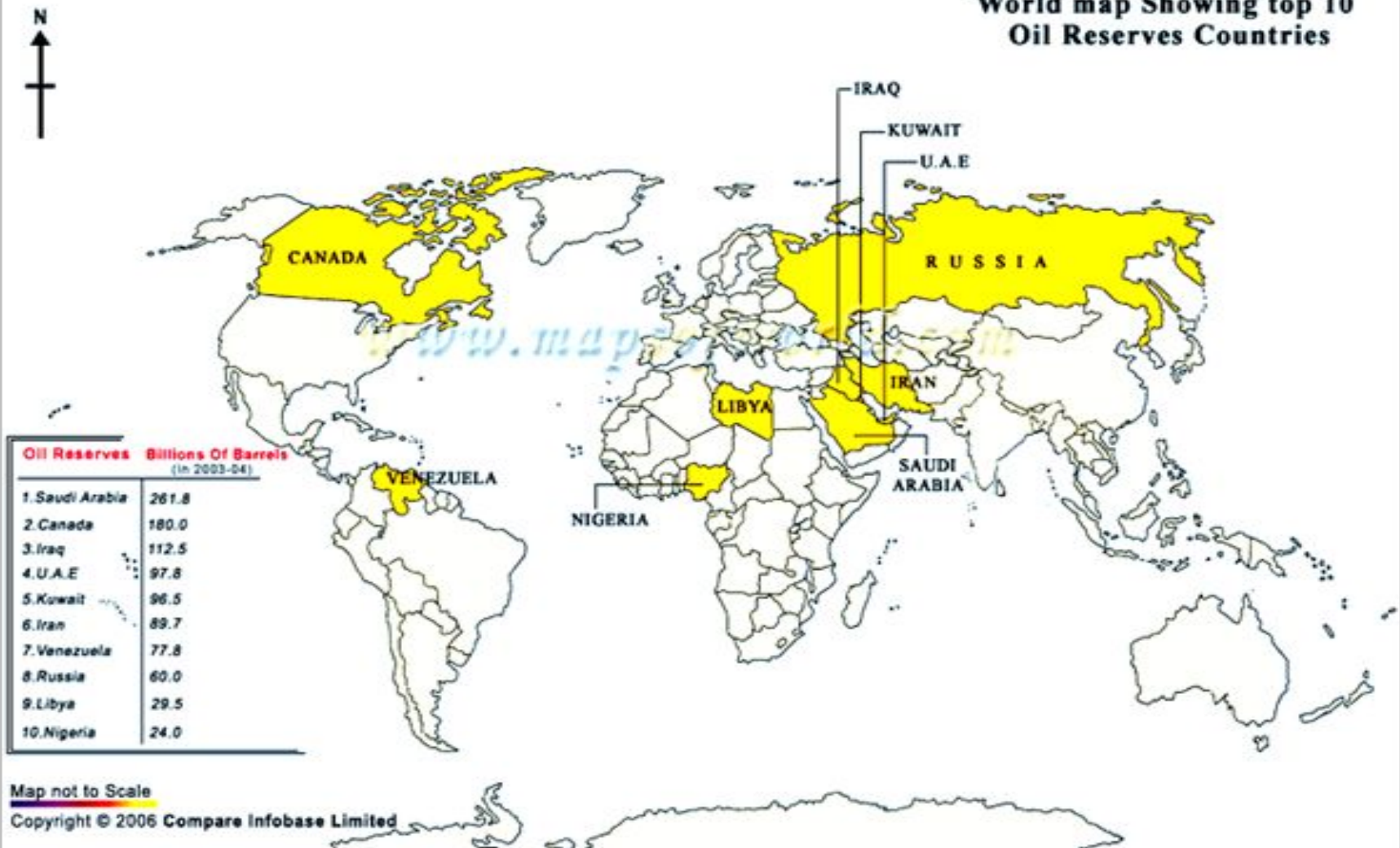

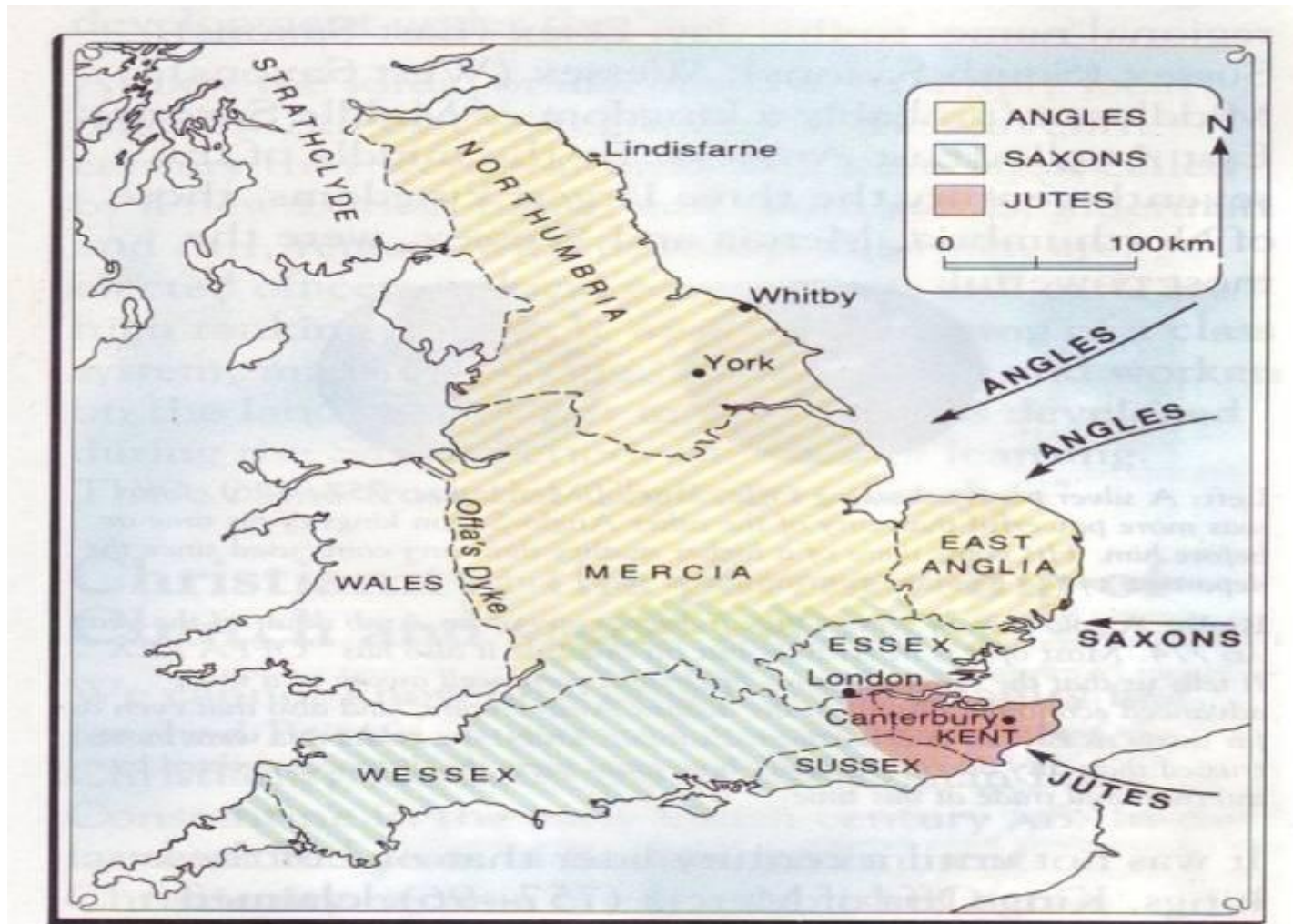

# ЛЕГЕНДА/LEGEND

- **Legend:** The reference area on a map that lists and explains the colours, symbols, line patterns, shadings, and annotation used on the map. The legend often includes the scale, origin, orientation, and other map information. **The legend of a map** is also called **the key** of the map that explains the symbols used on the map.

# **STEPS TO READING A MAP:**

- **Identify the Location**
- **Find the Key (the Legend)**
- **Check the Symbols of the Legend**
- **Check the scales if necessary**
- **Use the map to answer the questions**
