But in 14-th century Timur’s troops destroyed the city, and it was restored in 15-th century again and became the capital of khanats.



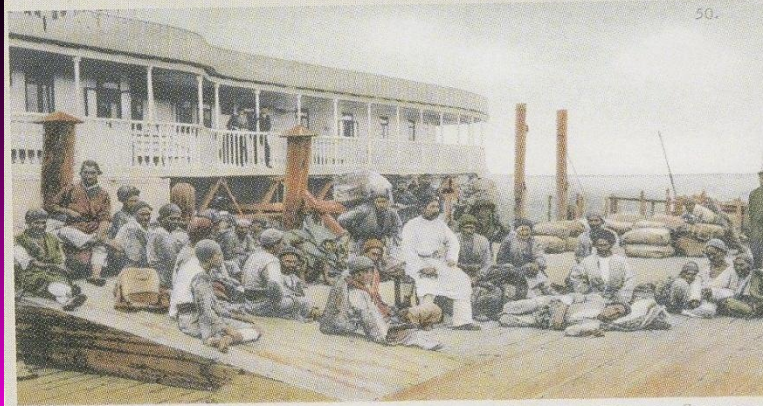

The Kremlin was built in Astrakhan in 16th century with many towers and Troitsky Cathedral.

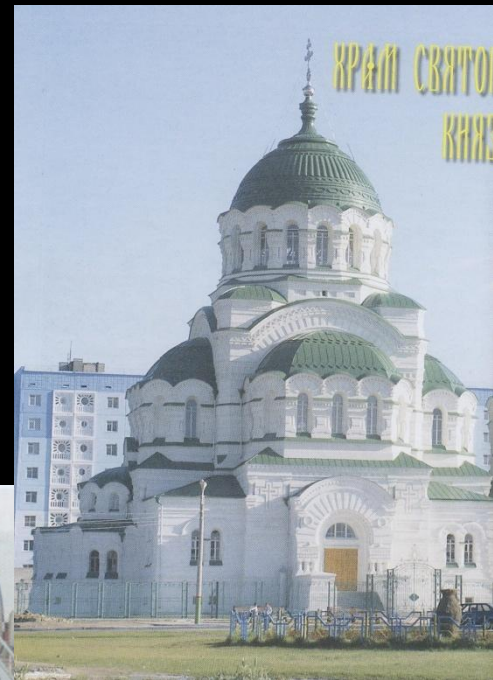


Peter the Great founded the Admiralty. He has built a port in the south of Russia.

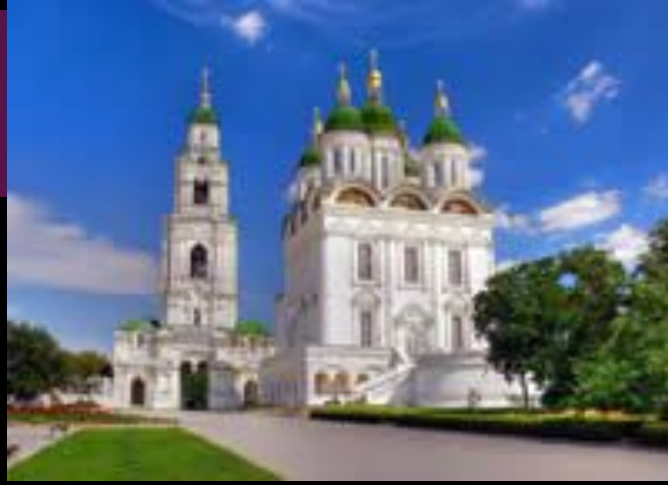




Astrakhan is a big and beautiful city now. There are more than 500 thousand inhabitants in it.
