It consist of 50 states.

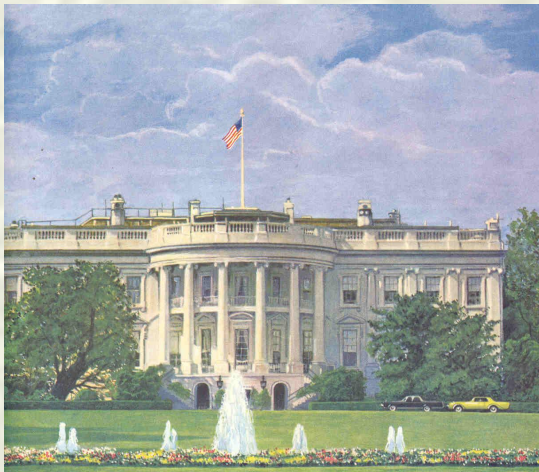

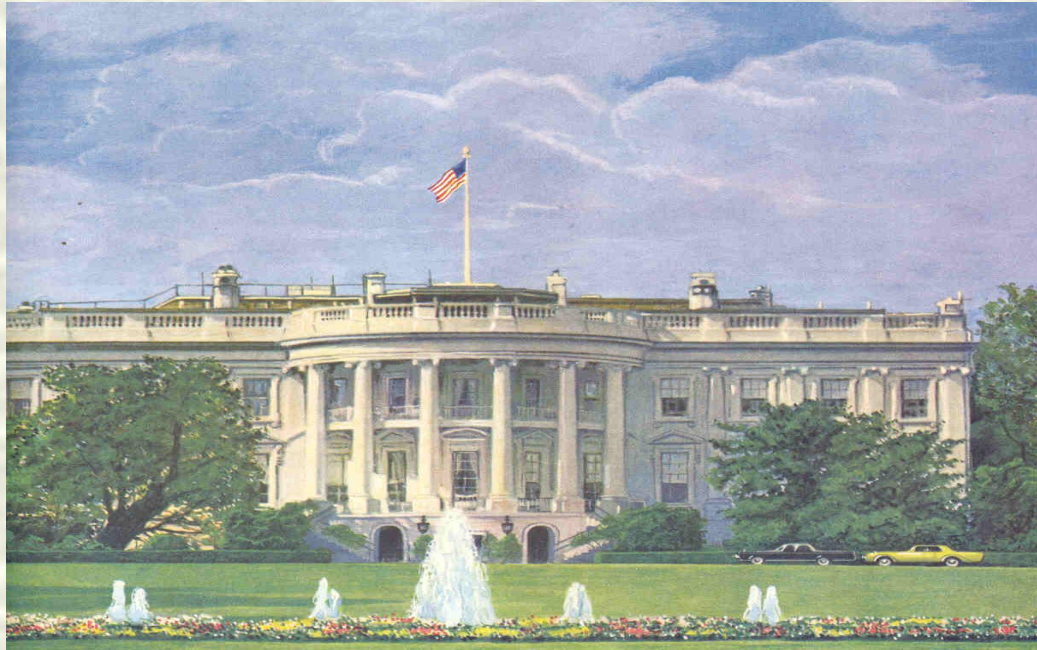

# The Statue of Liberty.

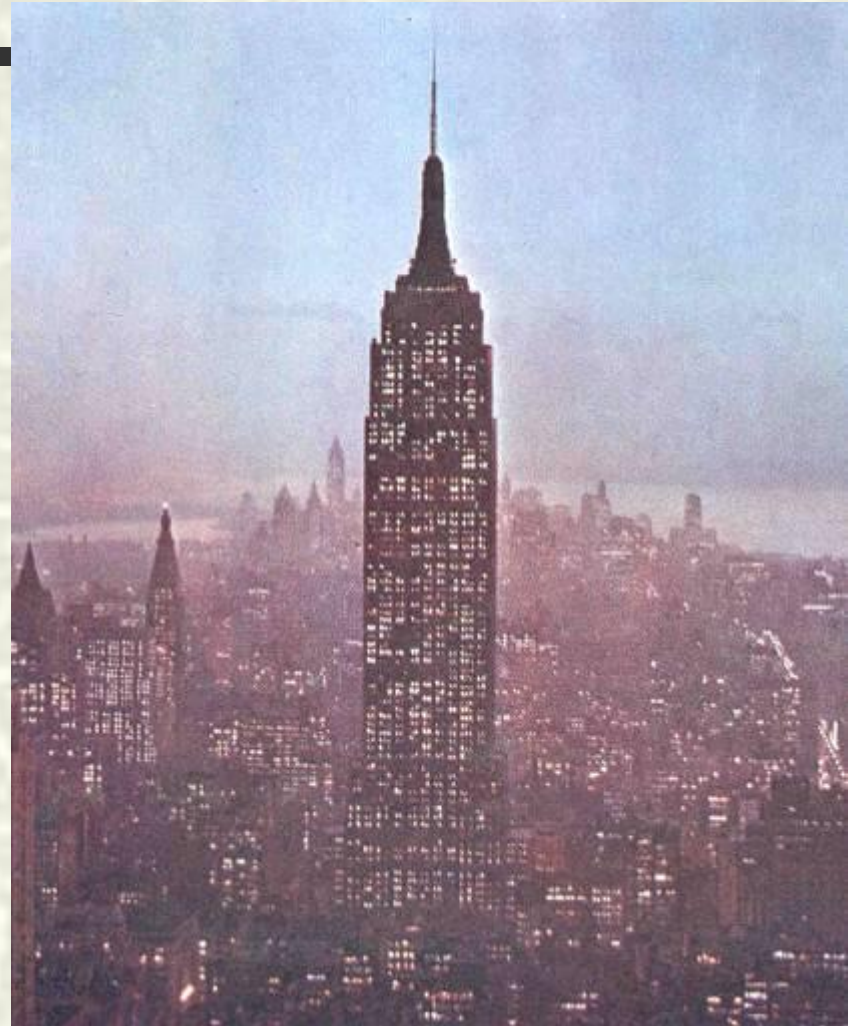


**It stands on a small island at the entrance to New York harbour. It is nearly 100 metres above the water level.**

Manhattan with Brooklyn.**

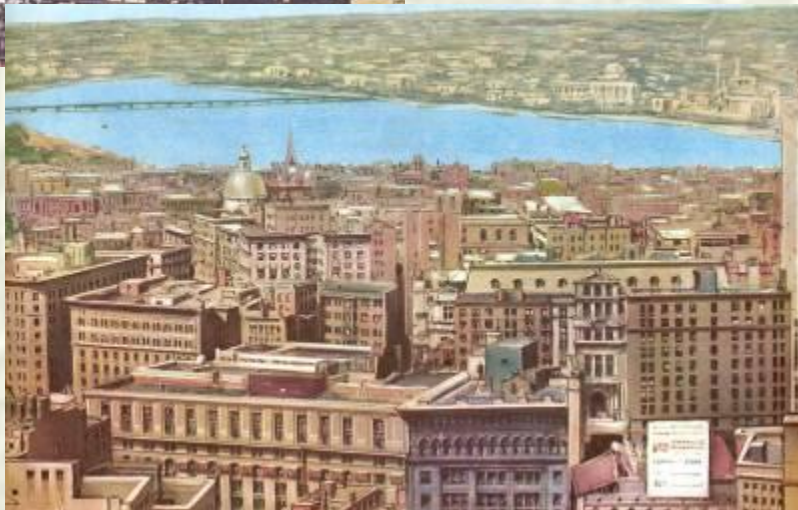


**There are a lot of other large cities in the USA.**
