**The modern London Bridge was built in 1973. It was officially opened by the Queen Elizabeth II. There is a memorial board on the bridge in honor of this event.**

# London Eye

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- ▣ **The London Eye is a giant Ferris wheel situated on the banks of the river Thames. It is the tallest Ferris wheel in Europe and the most popular attraction in the UK. The structure is 135 meters tall and the wheel has a diameter of 120 meters.**



# Trafalgar Square

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- Trafalgar Square is a public place in central London. In the centre of it there is Nelson's Column. The square is also used for political demonstrations and community gatherings, such as the celebration of New Year's Eve.
