- The British people are considered to be the world's greatest **tea** drinkers. They drink it at meals and between meals. The English tea is usually strong and **with milk**.



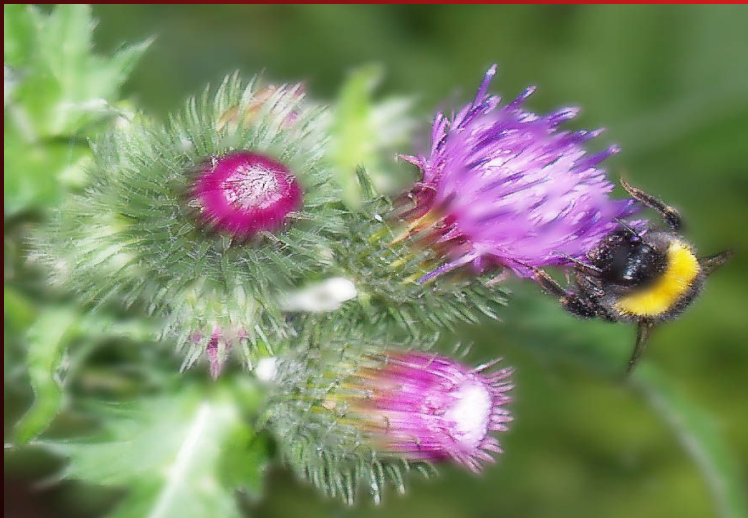

Wales.

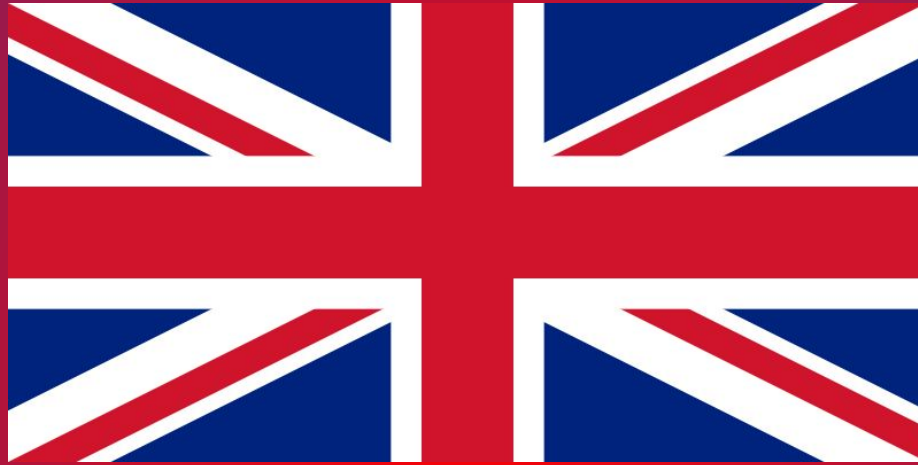
