Tower – a tall narrow building, often part of a castle

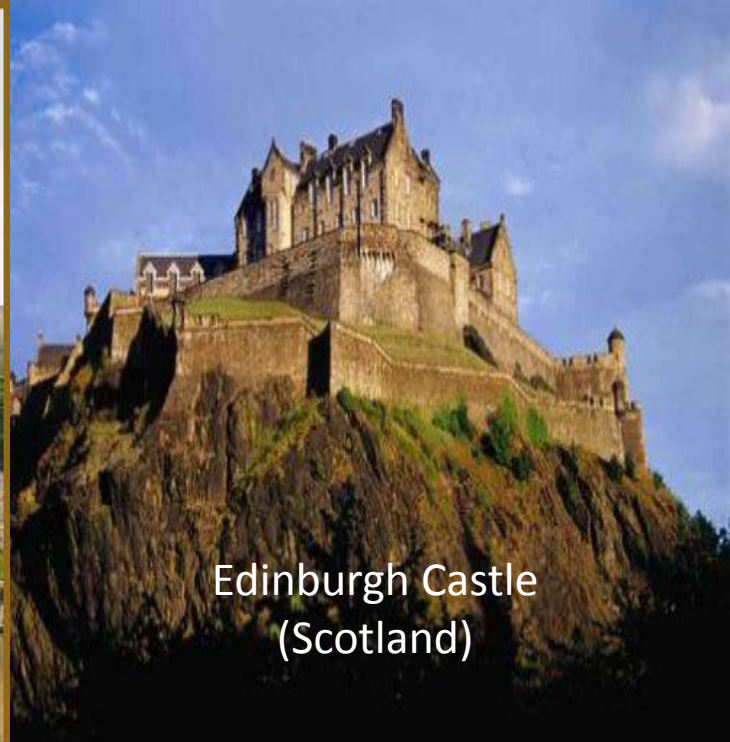
View - what you see from a place
