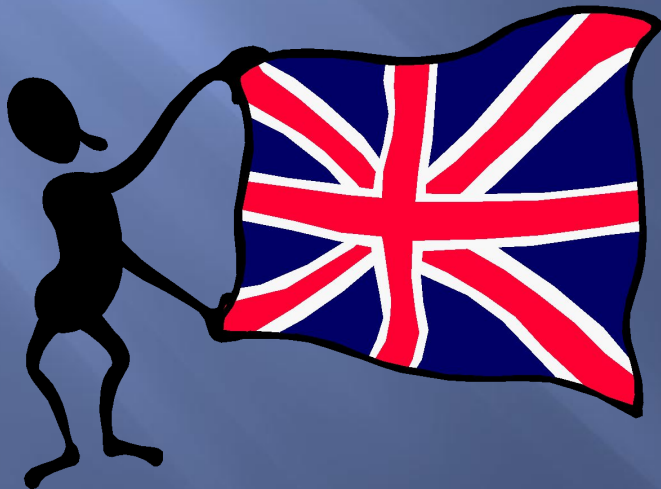


Welcome to the United Kingdom

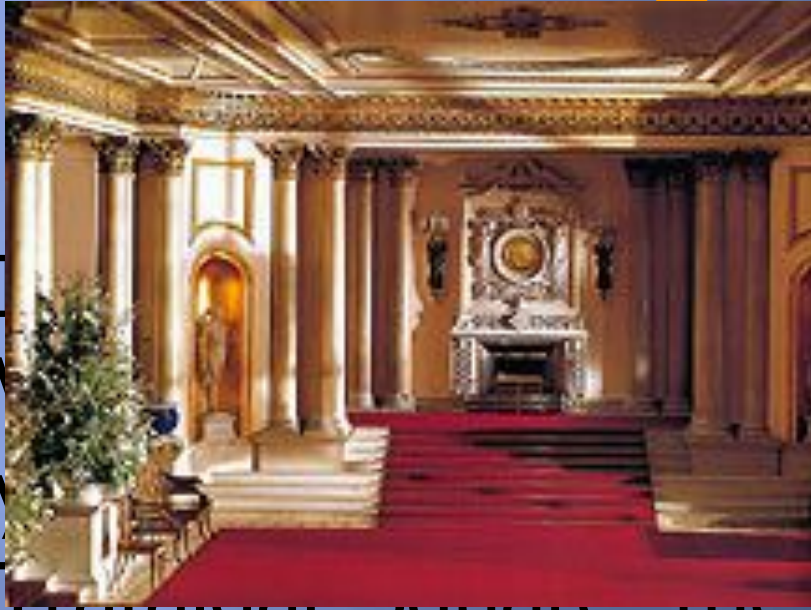

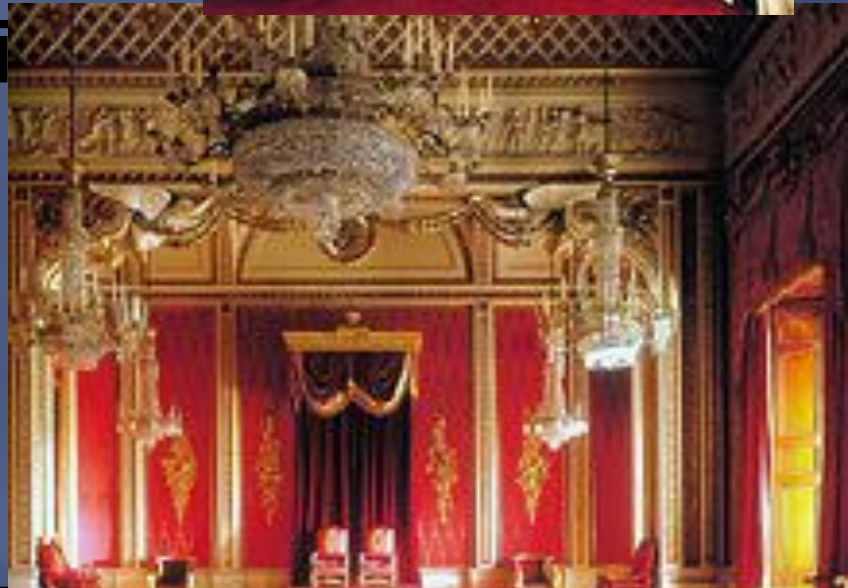
