The Statue of Liberty is one of the most famous symbol of America. It was built in New York Harbor in 1886. It was a gift from the people of France.








The Capitol

The tallest building in Washington, D.C. and the most famous building in the USA. The Capitol is surrounded by a beautiful garden with many trees and flowers.






The Guggenheim Museum






The Jefferson Memorial
