- not everything can be bought

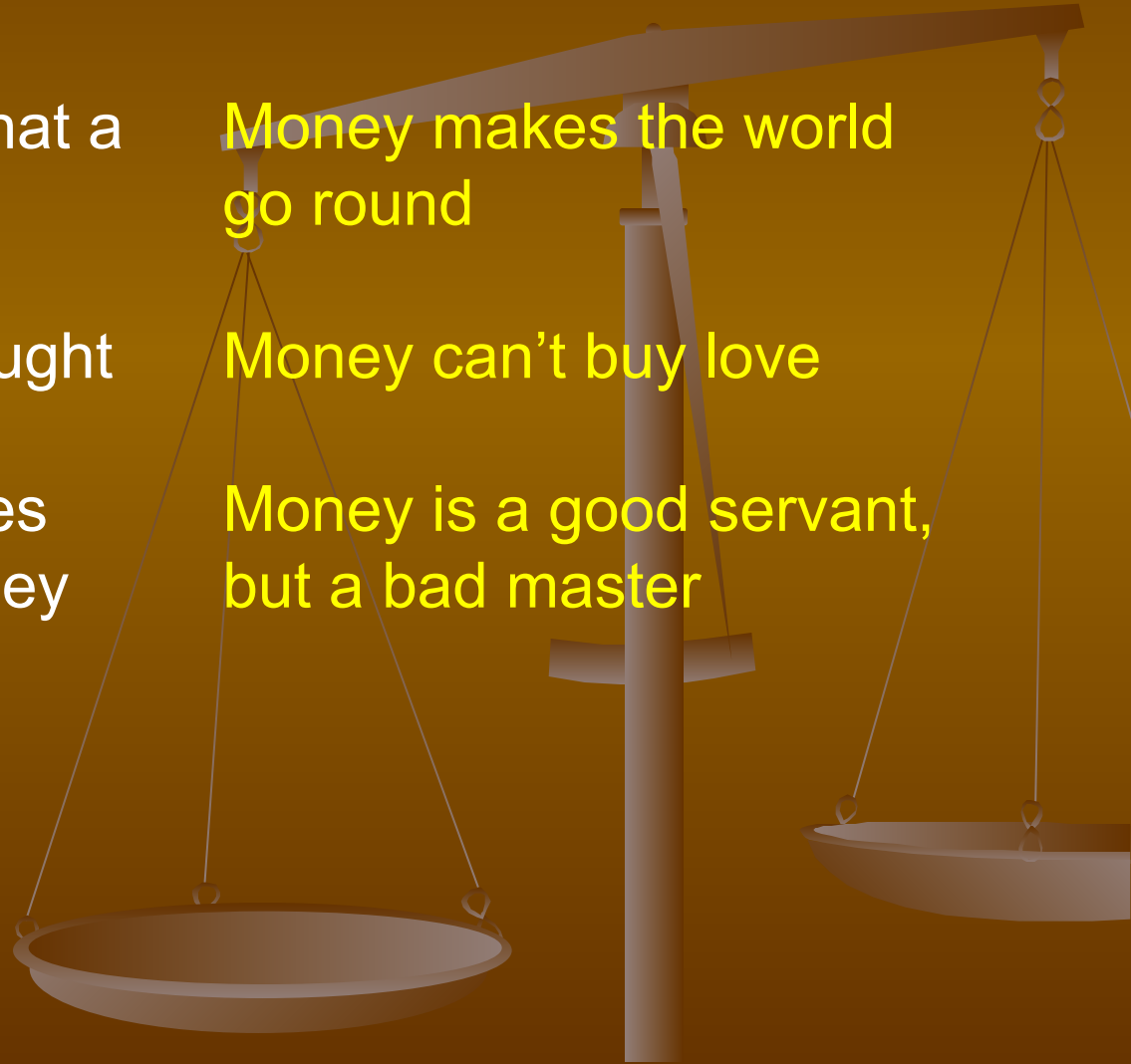
