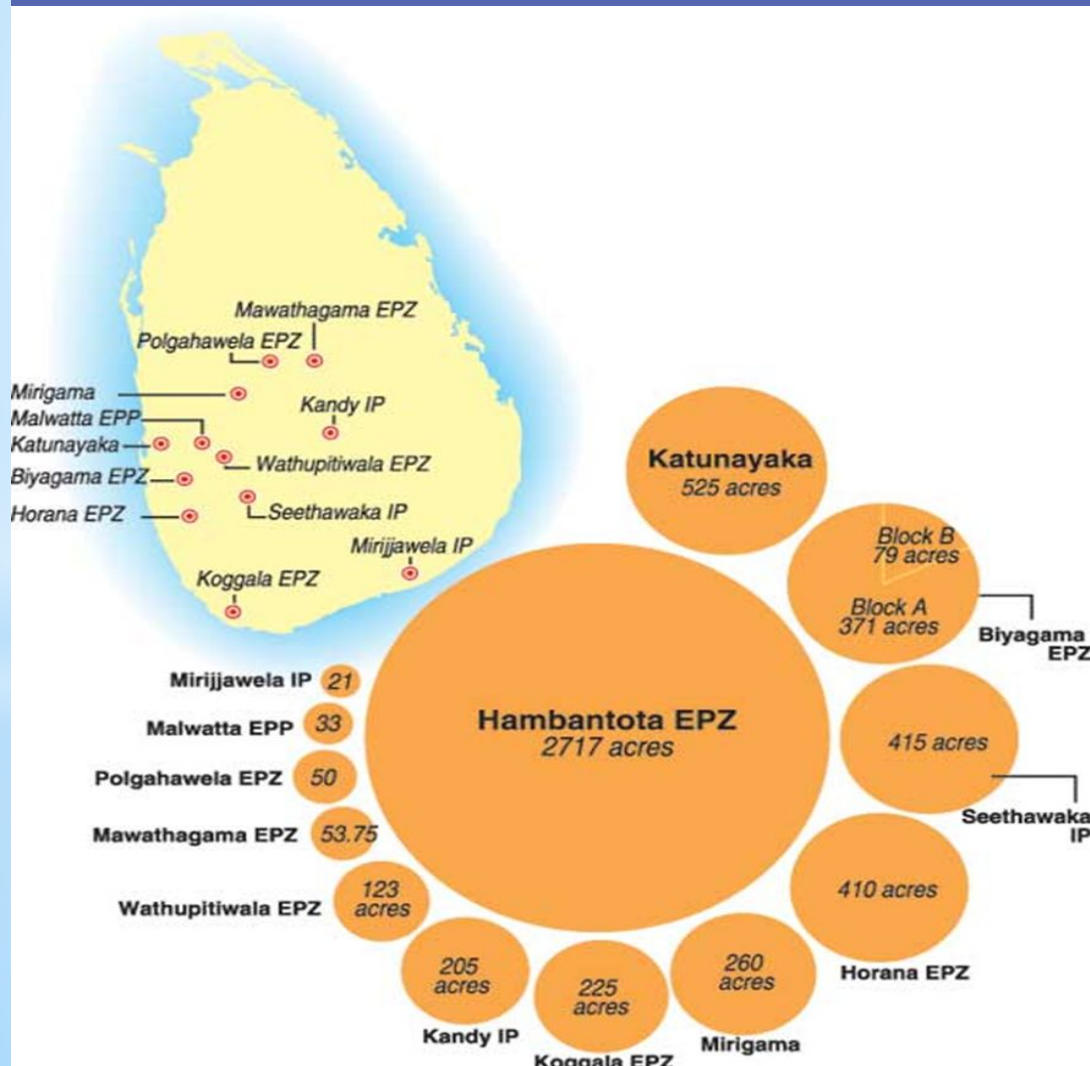
Most Viable Investment Opportunity in the world today
