

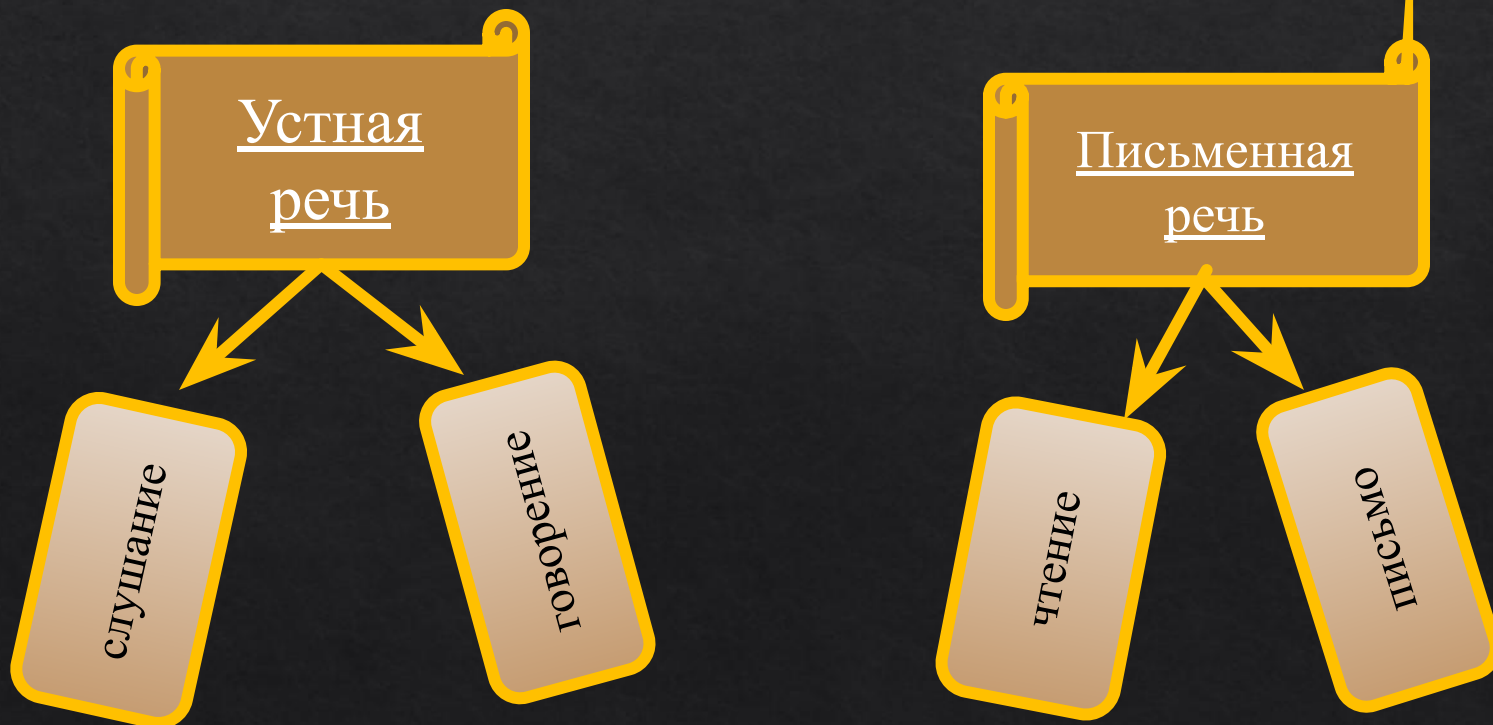

проблема и т.д.)

Этапы работы при обучении говорению

Путь – «сверху вниз» (видео)

I этап

- упражнения до просмотра видеосюжета на снятие трудностей понимания

II этап

- просмотр видеосюжета

III этап

- упражнения на проверку понимания и отработку лексических навыков после просмотра видеосюжета

IV этап

- говорение
