Gap year in Russia



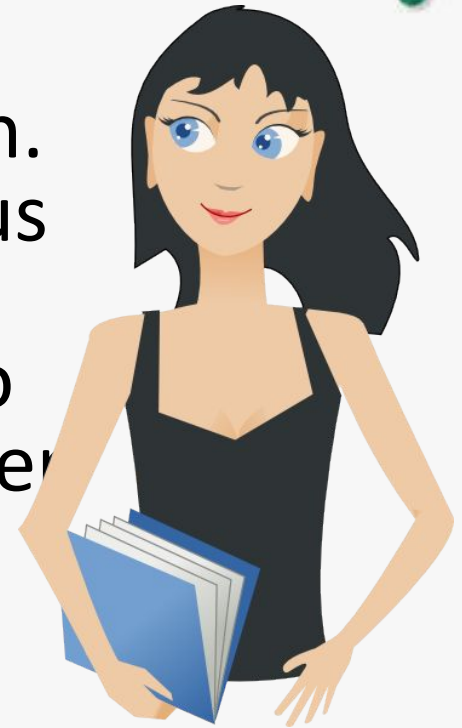

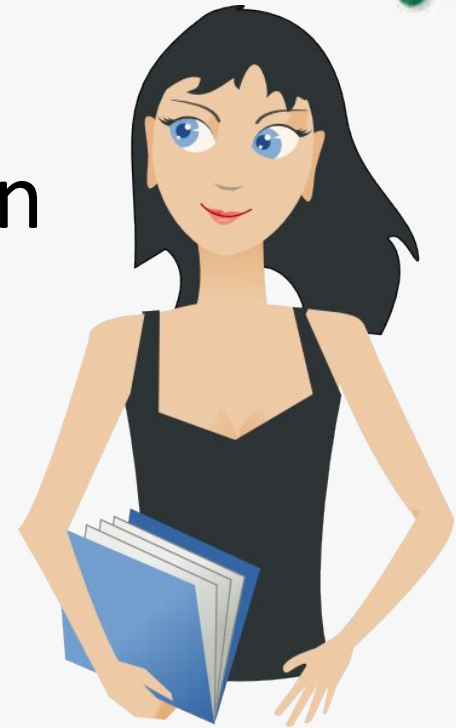
