1. Which tense is it?

1	You usually plant roses She usually plant <u>s</u> roses	
2	Do you usually plant roses? Does she usually plant_ roses?	
3	You don't usually plant roses She doesn't usually plant_ roses	

2. Which tense is it?

1	<p>You are planting</p> <p>She is planting</p>		<p>now</p> <p>now</p>
2	<p>Are you planting</p> <p>Is she planting</p>		<p>now?</p> <p>now?</p>
3	<p>You aren't planting</p> <p>She isn't planting</p>		<p>now</p> <p>now</p>

5. Which tense is it?

1	You planted		last year.
2	Did you plant_		last year?
3	You didn't plant_		last year.

6. Which tense is it?

1	You were planting She was planting		when he came. when he came.
2	Were you planting Was she planting		when he came? when he came?
3	You weren't planting She wasn't planting		when he came. when he came.




3. Which tense is it?

2	<p>Have you planted</p> <p>Has she planted</p>		<p><u>yet?</u></p> <p><u>yet?</u></p>

8. Which tense is it?

1	You had been planting he came.		for 2 hours when
2	Had you been planting came?		for 2 hours when he
3	You hadn't been planting when he came.		for 2 hours

11. Which tense is it?

1	She will have planted o'clock.		tomorrow by 3
2	Will she have planted		tomorrow by 3 o'clock?
3	She won't have planted o'clock.		tomorrow by 3

12. Which tense is it?

1	I shall have been planting		for 4 hours, when he comes.
2	Shall I have been planting		for 4 hours, when he comes?
3	I shan't have been planting		for 4 hours, when he comes.
