I. What is Law?

- Law (definition) set of
 - (1) <u>compulsory</u> norms of behavior
 - (2) sanctioned and enforced by government
 - (3) to be complied with by <u>all</u> people in the country
- Statute source of law, legal (i.e., binding/то есть, обязательный) act
 - Hierarchy of legal acts

II. Legal Acts

Example
