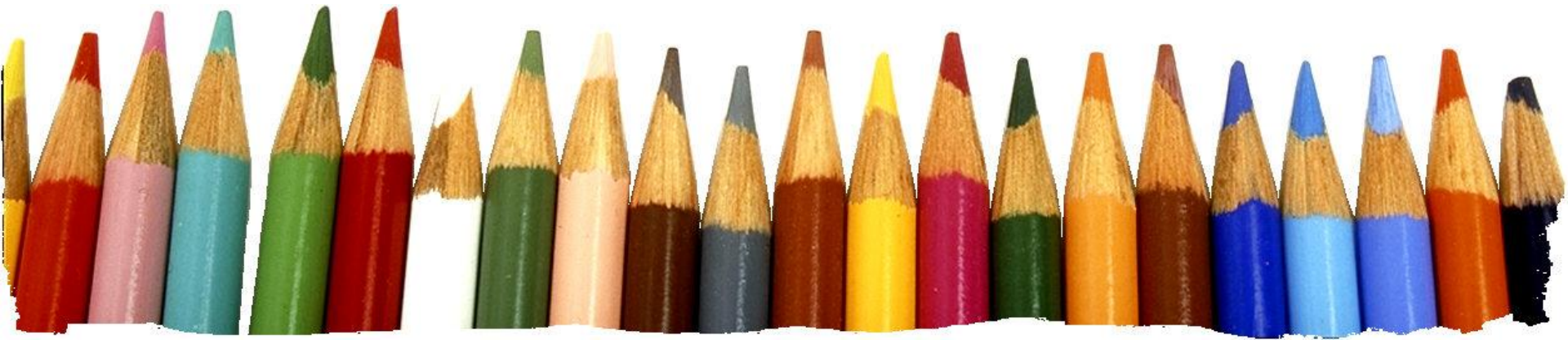


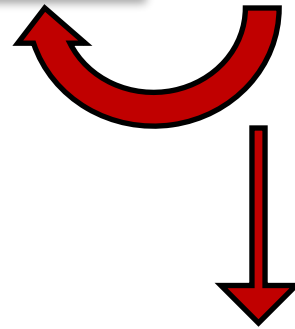
Defining relative clauses

Who / which / that



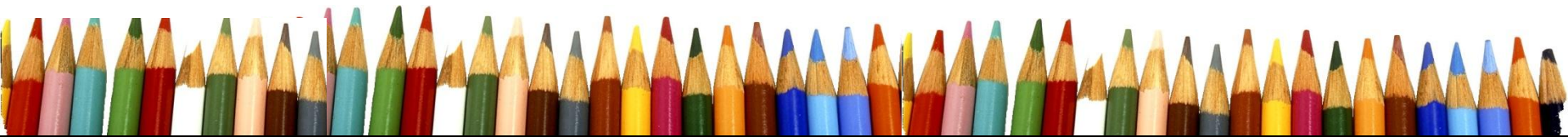
who

I usually speak to the woman. ~~She~~ owns the hotel.



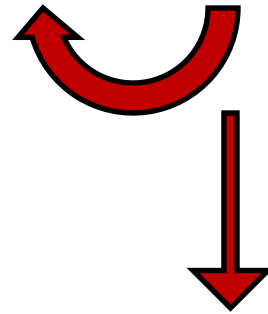
I usually speak to the woman **who** owns the hotel.

Use: people



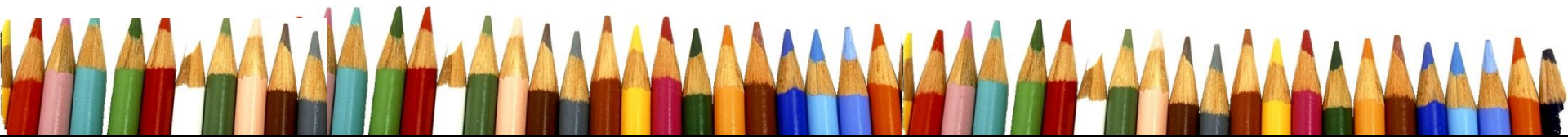
which

I have got a lovely dog. ✘ has got white fur.



I have got a lovely dog **which** has got white fur.

Use: things/animals



That

She's the teacher **who** came to our school last week.



She's the teacher **that** came to our school last week.

This is the house **which** belongs to my friend.



This is the house **that** belongs to my friend.

Use: That can replace who or which in defining relative clauses and in an informal style.
