




#### STONEHENGE

The land of Britain continues to preserve the history of the ancient peoples that once inhabited it. There are many architectural monuments remaining from the time of the Roman Empire. This is the huge defensive Adrian Wall - 118 kilometers long - that was to protect Rome's possessions in present-day Southern England from the raids of the warring Britts.

It is known that the Romans were extremely fond of all kinds of baths. They were the first to discover the curative properties of thermal (radon) waters and founded the town of Aqua Salts. Today, it is one of the most popular spas in the world - the city of Bath.

The mysterious Stonehenge is a remarkable structure of the Stone Age. Besides Stonehenge, there are also other ritual structures dating back to the Stone Age. The heritage of the Celts is indeed amazing. This horse of chalk from a hill in Beckshire shows an ancient Celtic goddess. The local residents have been looking after this monument for 2,000 years already.




## THE UNITED KINGDOM OF GREAT BRITAIN AND NORTHERN IRELAND (THE UK)


