The Future Simple Tense





The Future Simple Tense употребляется для обозначения какого-либо действия в будущем.



The Future Simple Tense (Будущее простое время)

Для времени the Future Simple характерно употребление следующих наречий:

- **tomorrow** 3aBTpa She will read this book tomorrow
- in a year через год I will go to school in a year
- in two days через два дня They will watch TV in two days
- next week на следующей неделе We will visit this place next week
 - year hour summer autumn winter
 - spring



Вопросительные слова



Nick will play football next summer.

Who will play football next summer?

We often use will in there situations:

Offering to do something:

- I need some money. Don't worry. I'll lend you some.
- Agreeing or refusing to do something:
- I've asked John to help me but he won't.
 Promising to do something:
- I promise I'll phone as soon as I arrive.
- Asking someone to do something (Will you...?):
- Will you shut the door, please?
