


Loch Morar is the deepest lake. It's 309 metres deep.

Mountains in the UK are not very high compared with some range of mountains in Europe like the Alps or the Pyrenees.



Shetlands Islands are in the Atlantic Ocean in the North of Great Britain.






North Cornwall, a nature reserve in the South West.




