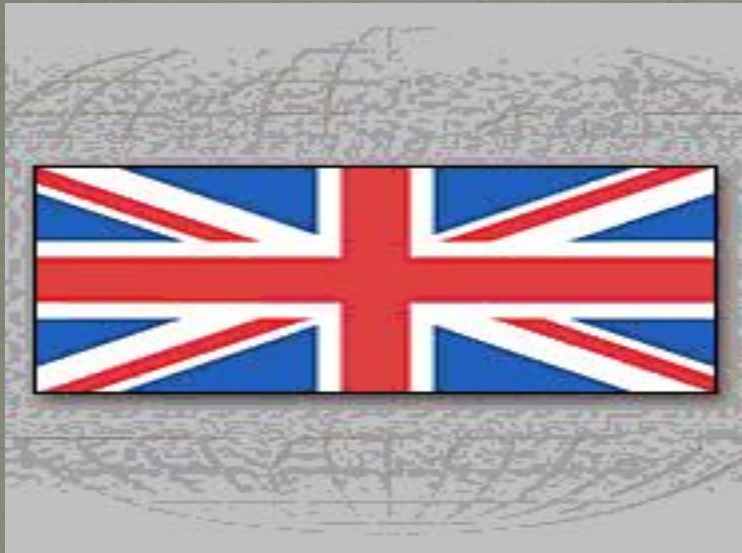

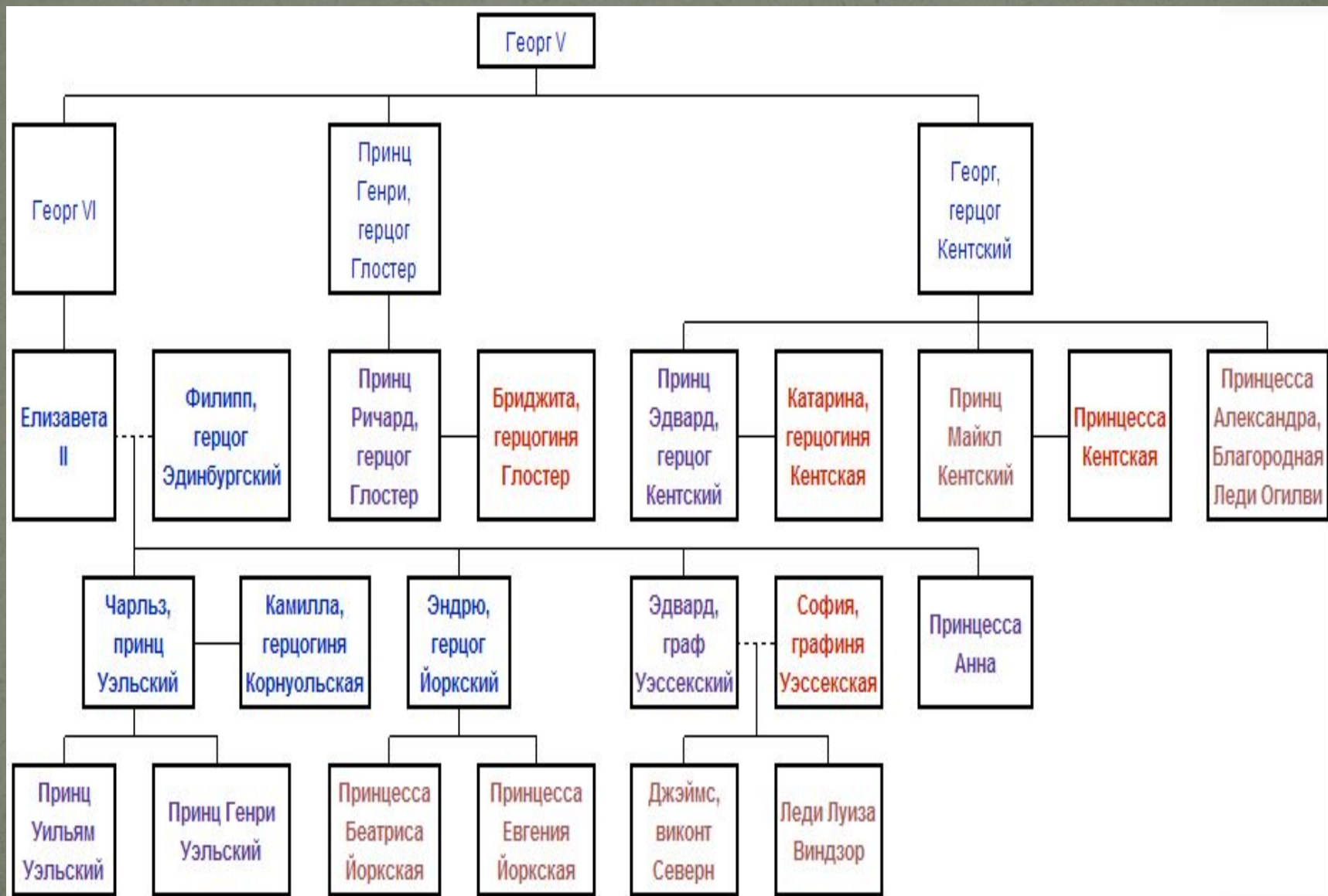
Purpose:

George V

Born June 3, 1865 in London, the second son of Edward VII. Got a naval education and served in the Navy. Reigned 1910g. May 6-January 20, 1936. Died January 20, 1936.



Edward VIII

Born June 23, 1894, the eldest great-grandson of Queen Victoria.

King of Great Britain and Ireland, Emperor of India for 10 months, was not crowned. Abdicated to marry divorcee Wallis Simpson. Died May 28, 1973.



George VI

Born on 14 December 1895. King of Great Britain, Canada, Australia and South Africa from December 11, 1936. The last emperor of India, the last king of Ireland. Ascended the throne after the abdication of his brother Edward VIII. The second son of King George V. Died on 6 February 1952.



Lady Elizabeth Bowes-Lyon *(Queen Mother)*

She was born in 1900.
Daughter of Count
Stamorskogo. In 1923,
married the Duke of York
(later George VI). Queen
Mother ruling ElizavetyII.
Lived 102 years and was
loved by most British
people. She died in 2002.



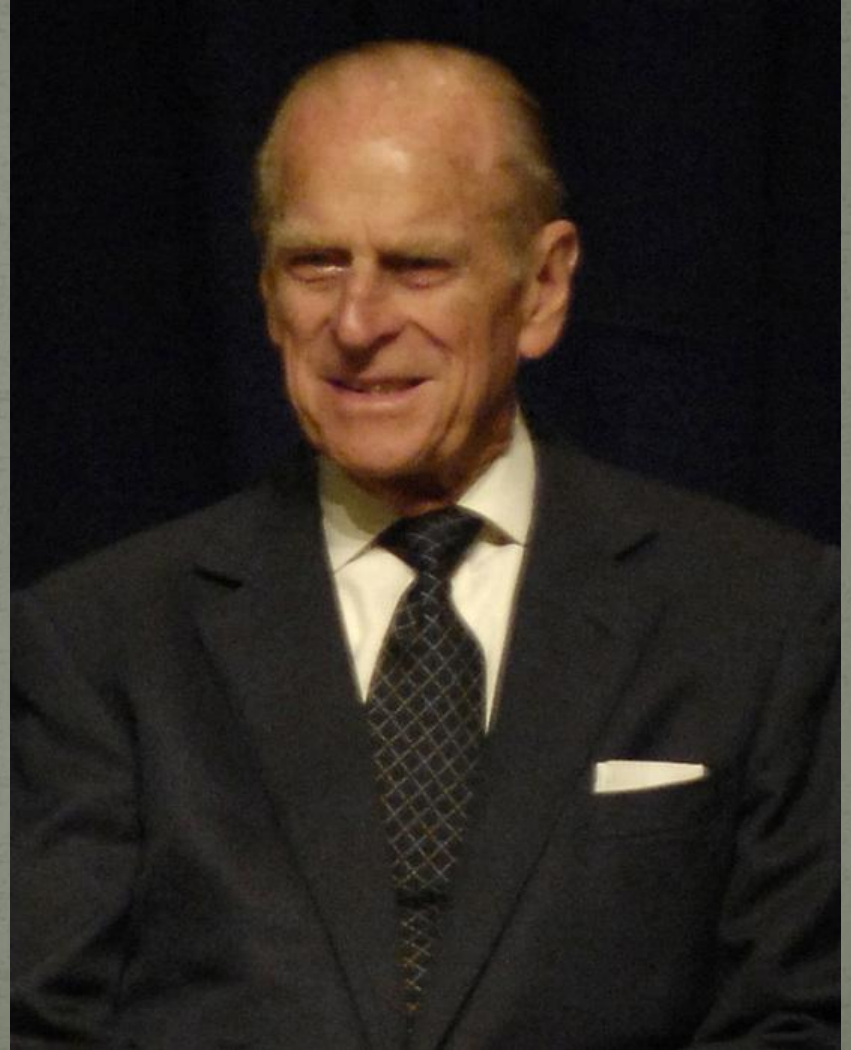
Elizabeth II

Was born on 21 April 1926., In London - the reigning queen and head of state of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, as the queen of 15 States of the Commonwealth, the head of the Anglican Church, chief of the armed forces and the Lord of the Isle of Man. Since 1953. by 1961. was Queen of South Africa. Enthroned February 6, 1952, crowned June 2, 1953



Prince Philip

He was born in 1921.
Greek Hellenic son
Prince Andrew. The
Duke of Edinburgh. He
is married to Queen
Elizabeth II.

Princess Anne

She was born in 1950. The only daughter of Queen Elizabeth II. Married Timothy Laurence. Two children. President Compassionate Fund "Save the Children" and a member of the International Olympic Committee.



Prince Andrew

He was born in 1960. The second son, the third child and the Duke of Edinburgh Queen Elizabeth II. Duke of York. From 1986 to 1992. married to Sarah Ferguson. Has two daughters. Director of a large international company.



Prince Edward

He was born in 1964. The third son, the fourth child of the royal couple. Duke of Wessex. Since 1999 married to Sophia Rees-Jones. Have two children. Engaged in support of various organizations working on international youth program AWARD.



Prince Charles

He was born in 1948. The first son, the first child of the Duke of Edinburgh and Queen Elizabeth II. The Prince of Wales. Heir to the throne. Married: s1981 to 1992. by Diana Spencer, two children; since 2005. Camilla Parker. Has been serving the military.





Camilla Parker Bowles. She was born in 1947. The Duchess of Cornwall. The second wife of Prince Charles.



Diana Spencer. She was born in 1961. Princess of Wales. first wife of Prince Charles. Died in 1997. in a car accident.

Prince William

He was born in 1982.
The eldest son, the first
child of Prince Charles
of Wales and Princess
Diana. The Prince of
Wales.
Heir. President of the
English Football
Association.



Prince Harry

He was born in 1984.
The second son, the
second child of Prince
of Wales and Princess
Diana. The Prince of
Wales. Studying at the
military academy.

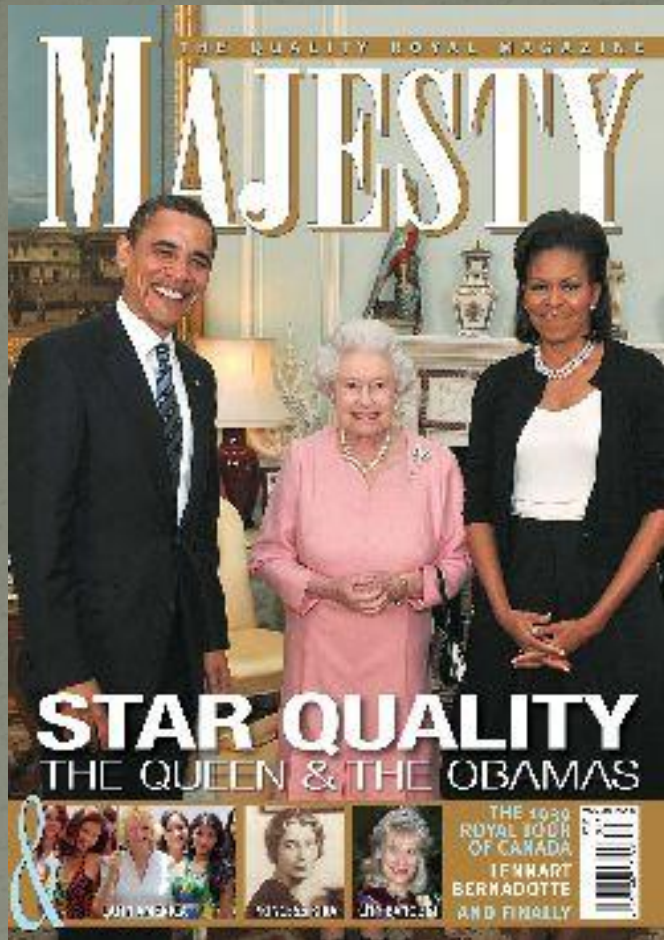
