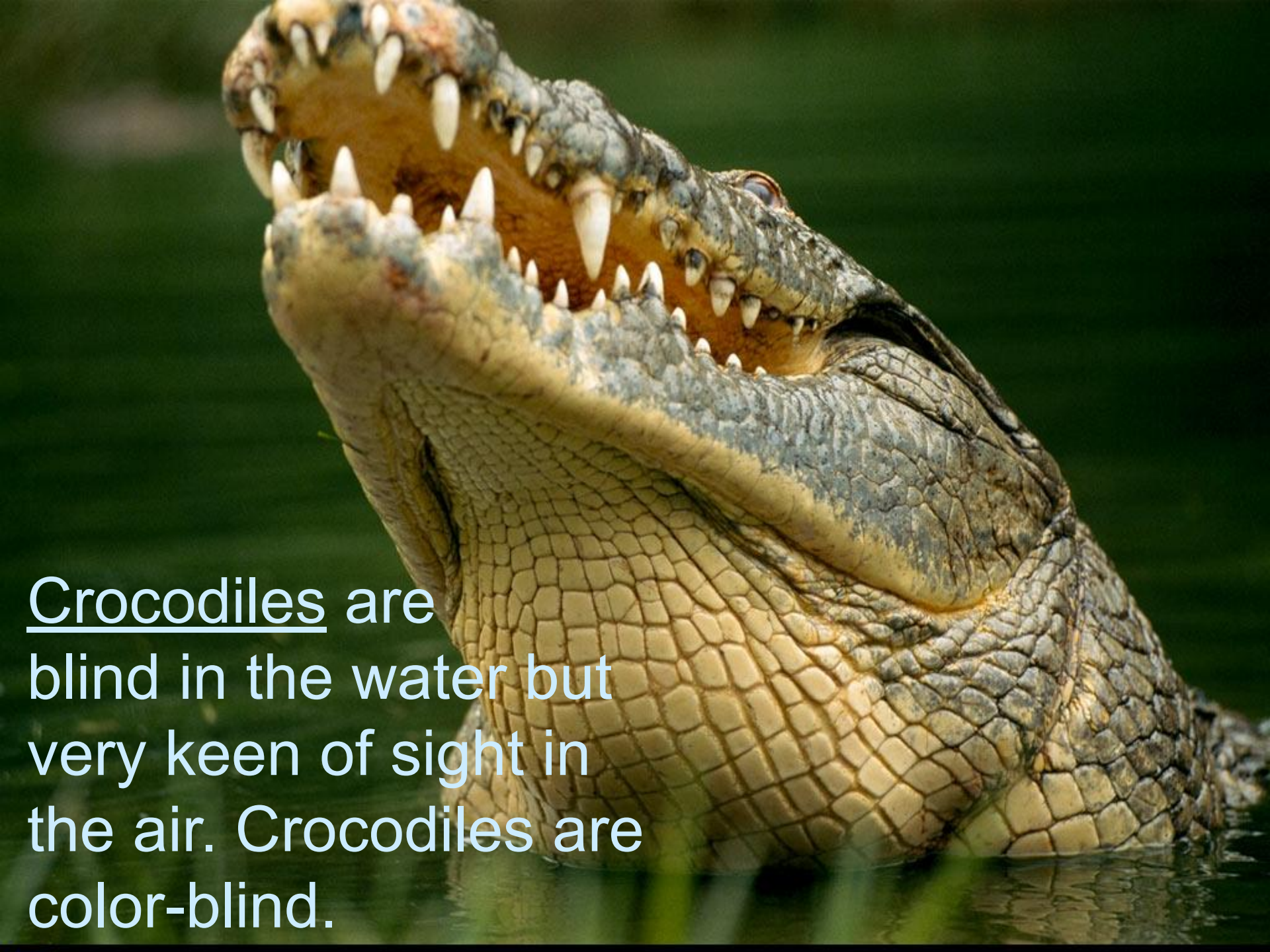

own weight

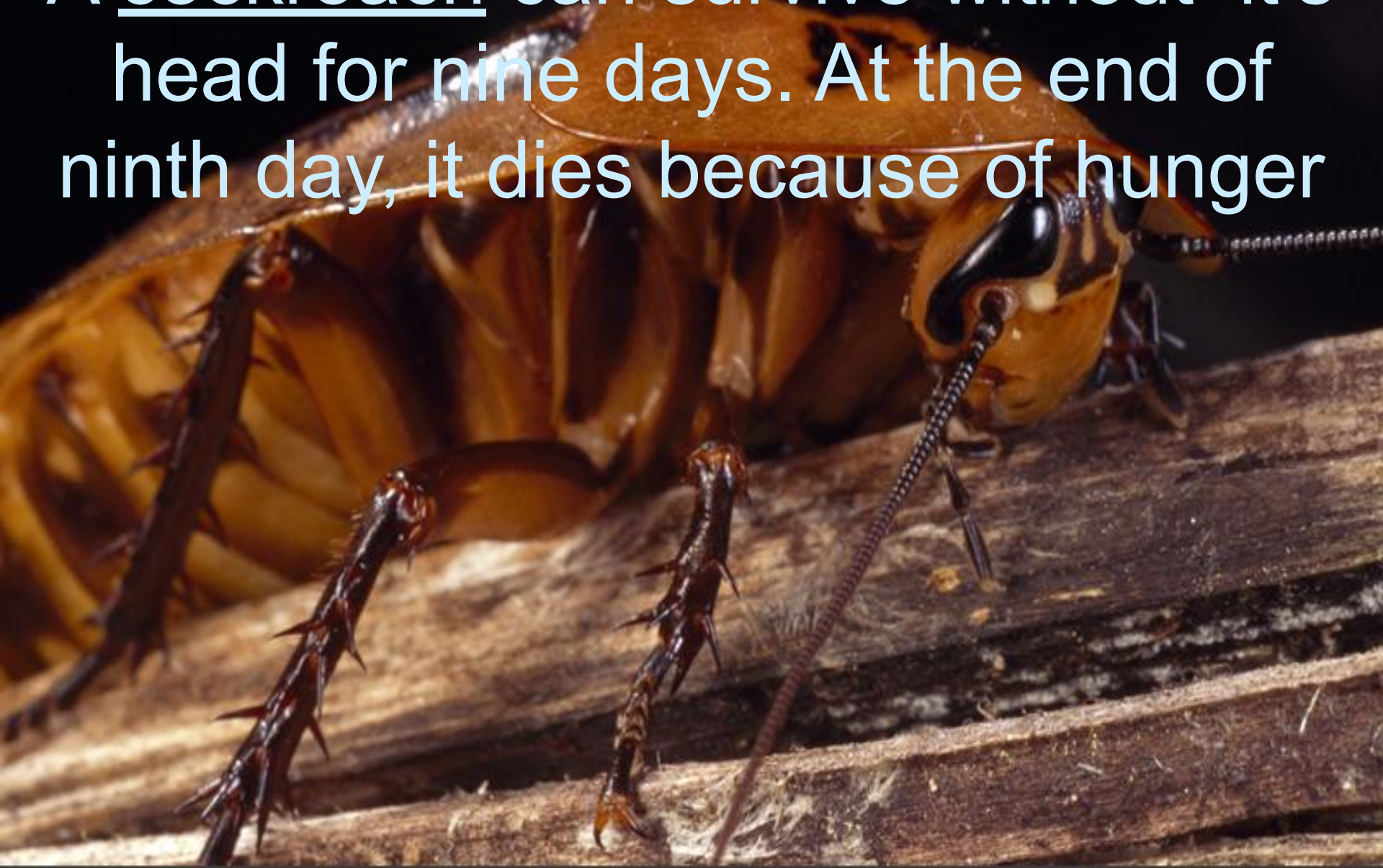






Giraffes
