4) All Ancient Romans had free entry to the Colosseum for events, and was also fed throughout the show.



## 5) The Colosseum in Italy only took 9 years to build using over 60,000 Jewish slaves.



6) The original name of the Coliseum was **Flavian Amphitheater**, after the Flavian Dynasty of Emperors.
