Stages of Premeditated Crimes



are stages of crime committing characterized by public danger and character (art 15 CC), consists of attempt on crime committing, punishment is designed in the art 15 CC

Criminal Punishment

- Is a special measure of state enforcement
- System of punishment:
 - Capital punishment (death penalty) – moratorium at present
 - Imprisonment
 - Withdrawal
 - Public works without arrest
 - Prohibition to be on post or run any profitable activity



Criminal Punishment

- Dismissing from the post
- Fines
- Disciplinary battalions – for militants
- Property confiscation
- Depriving of relative rights
- Depriving of awards, medals and honorable titles etc
