


Base - Court Decision

Corpus Delicti


- Features:

- 3 types of criminal Law:
 - Main or simple
 - Qualified
 - Mitigation

Criminal Law Activity in Space

Criminal Punishment

- Is a special measure of state enforcement
- System of punishment:
 - Capital punishment (death penalty) moratorium at present
 - Imprisonment
 - Withdrawal
 - Public works without arrest
 - Prohibition to be on post or run any profitable activity
